



ECS Toyota Young Investigator Fellowship Application Submission Instructions

Submitting Using the Online Awards System:

The award system is used for several of the Society's awards. In order to successfully submit the application, you will need to follow these instructions:

- 1. **Visit:** www.electrochem.org/submitaward and indicate that you have read and understand the instructions.
- 2. Select Award Type: Society Awards
- 3. Select Award: ECS Toyota Young Investigator Fellowship
- 4. Select Primary Topical Interest Area: Choose the area that best reflects your proposal focus
- 5. Complete the Nominee Information:
 - a. Prefix: Select your desired prefix
 - b. First (Given) Name
 - c. Last (Family) Name
 - d. Organization Name (DO NOT USE ABBREVIATIONS)
 - e. Email Address
- 6. Complete Nominator Information: Repeat your information in this section
 - a. You must enter your email address in the NOMINATOR EMAIL to receive a submission confirmation.
- 7. **Proposed Citation for Award:** Potential Title of Journal Article
- 8. Summary of Nominee Qualifications: List qualifications or reference an attached CV.
- 9. Nomination Packet:
 - a. Nomination Letter: Research Proposal
 - b. Additional Document (1): ECS Toyota Young Investigator Fellowship Nomination Form
- 10. Review all material
- 11. **Check** the "reCAPTCHA" to confirm you are not a robot.
- 12. Click: Submit Award Nomination

You will receive a confirmation email from the system with your Application ID. Please keep this email for your records and reference your Application ID.

NOTES:

- You must be an ECS Member in good standing to be considered for the award. You can join or renew your membership by visiting: https://www.electrochem.org/individual-membership
- This application process does not require letters of support.
- A curriculum vitae (CV) is not required for this application; however, you may upload your CV if you choose. Utilize the "CV" location under the Nomination Packet.
- Do not upload the submission instructions (this page) with your application material.

Select "Society Awards" under "Award Type" and then select "ECS Toyota Young Investigator Fellowship" from the pull-down menu.
