



### Destinations Along Cimarron River: Numbers in text correspond to numbers on map.

All sites at Tolby, Ponderosa & Maverick Campgrounds are by Reservation Only. Reservations are through ReserveAmerica from May to September 15.

- Tolby Campground-Modern restroom, 3 water hydrants and 22 campsites (24' to 35' in length) with tables and grills. Park Office located at east end of campground.
  Tolby Free Angler Access Area is located near the entrance to campground.
- Tolby Trail-Choice of upper or lower routes. Excellent wildlife viewing area. A Park Pass, HMAV stamp, Hunting, Fishing or Trapping license is required. Check Game and Fish website for summer closures.
- Special Trout Waters-Go to wildlife dgf-nm-gov/ for special trout water fishing restrictions or see Fishing Proclamation for rules and regulations.
- Horseshoe Mine Day Use Area-Provides fishing access to Beaver ponds on the Cimarron River.

- **5. Perryville Day Use Area-**Parking area provides fishing access to the Cimarron River.
- 6. Clear Creek Trail-Scenic with several waterfalls and excellent wildlife viewing opportunities. Located at mile post 292. On south side of canyon. The trail follows the creek for 1.6 miles. A Park Pass, HMAV stamp, Hunting, Fishing or Trapping license is required. Check Game and Fish website for summer closures.
- 7. Blackjack Tent Camping and Day Use Area-5 developed tent campsites with tables, grills and vault toilet facilities. River runs next to campsites, no drinking water is available. Camping during summer season only (Memorial Day Weekend through Labor Day Weekend).
- 9. Jasper and Agate-Excellent wildlife viewing opportunities. Located at mile post 293. The trail is approximately 2.9 miles long. A Park Pass, HMAV stamp, Hunting, Fishing or Trapping license is required. Check Game and Fish website for summer closures
- Palisades Day Use Area-Quality picnic area with tables, grills and vault toilet facilities. Located across from Palisades Cliffs, which are 300' crenelated granite formations. User fees apply. (No rock climbing allowed.)
- Maverick Campground-2 modern restrooms, 5 water hydrants and 44 campsites (20' to 30' in length) with tables and grills. Fishing ponds near area.


- Maverick Trail-Scenic area with excellent wildlife viewing opportunities. The trail is approximately 6.2 miles long. A Park Pass, HMAV stamp, Hunting, Fishing or Trapping license is required. Check Game and Fish website for summer closures.
- 12. Ponderosa Campground-Modern restroom, 3 water hydrants and 14 campsites around parking lot with tables and grills, 4 tent sites at east end of campground with tables and grills.


Special Note: Restrooms and potable water services are shut down September 15 through the second weekend of May.










