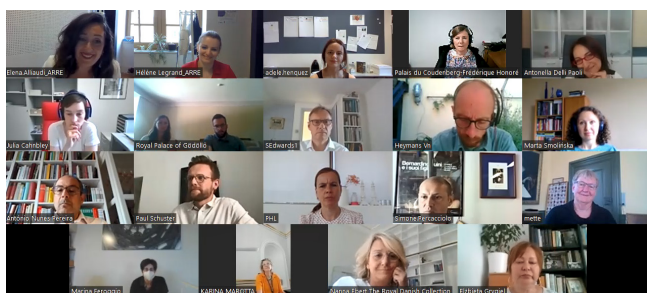

Palace Day: Centre for Historic Houses not demolish but preserve Sultan Palace

New Delhi, July 19 (PTI) A university-based centre that celebrates historic house staff and cultural enthusiasts on Tuesday appealed to the Bihar government to the century-old Sultan Palace in Patna, saying the move will squander away a "treasure" and "denude the rich architectural fabric" of the city.

July 19 marks the Palace Day, which under the patronage of the Network of European Residences seeks to celebrate the common heritage, and gives owners of such a platform to share their history and stories with a wider audience, leveraging the media.

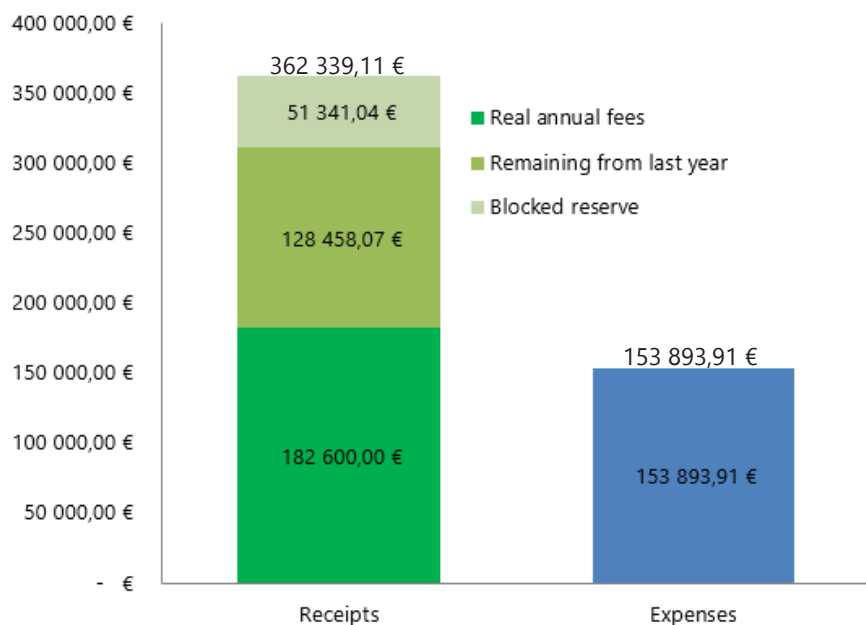

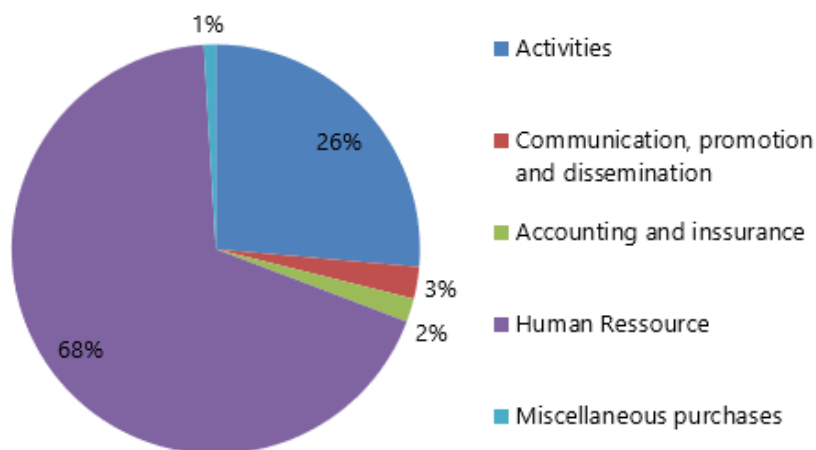

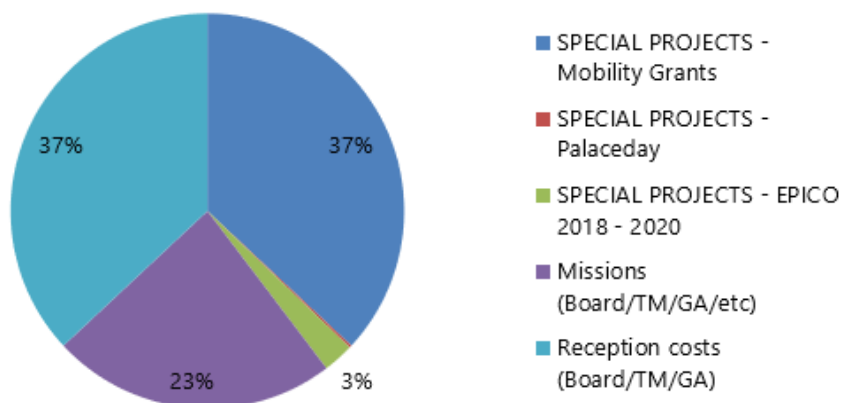
General Budget 2022
