Textiles were important in the 17thC home and Charlie tried hard to select the right fabrics and source antiques of the Tudor period. 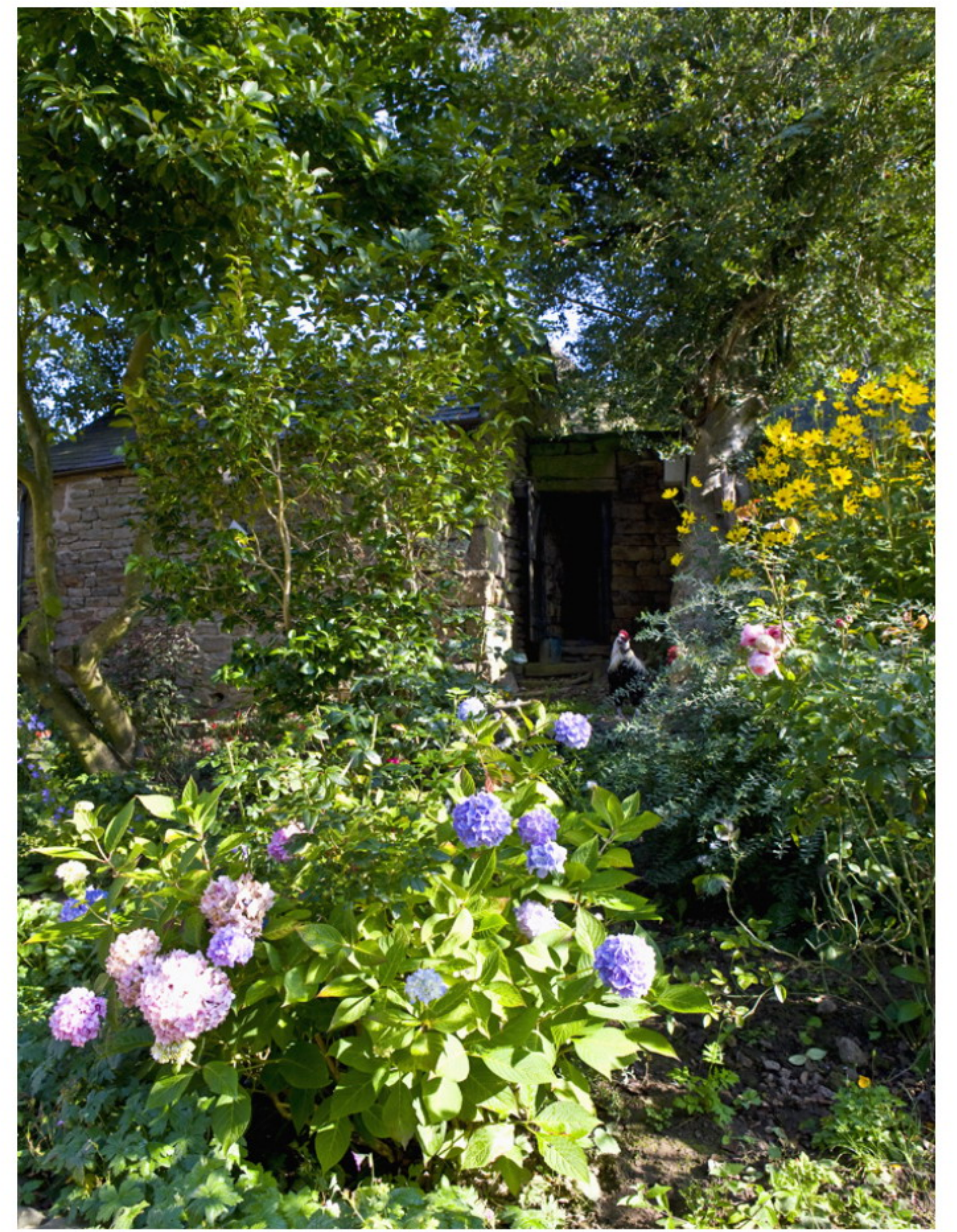
