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Introduction

The 2023 Municipal Census was conducted by the City of Fort Saskatchewan's Legislative Services Department.

This summary report provides data collected between April 1, 2023, and June 14, 2023, with the information being collected as at April 1, 2023. The census includes data such as the number of residents in each dwelling unit, the age and gender of each person, employment status, employment location, length of residence in the City, and more.

Methodology

Data collection for the 2023 Municipal Census began on April 1 through the City's secure online census website. Residents could use the Secure Access Code (SAC) delivered to their dwelling unit to begin the online census process; SACs were delivered to every dwelling unit by census enumerators.

After April 22nd, census enumerators visited households that had not yet completed their census online, so that they could collect responses directly from each dwelling.

Dwellings with no response after SAC circulation and enumerator visits were called by members of the Legislative Services team.

2023 Municipal Census Report

Results

This final report represents the results of the census in tables and figures. Where possible, census data from previous years are provided for comparison and to identify population trends.

Total Population

The total population of Fort Saskatchewan as of April 1, 2023, was 28,624 (Table 1). This includes 342 residents of the Fort Saskatchewan Correctional Centre. The population has increased by 1682 residents in 2023 from 2019, which represents an increase of 6.24% (Table 2).

Population by Gender

In 2023, 43.67% of the population identify as female, 43.47% as male, 12.63% are not stated, 0.12% are transgender and 0.11% identify as Non-Binary (Table 2).

Table 3 and Figure 1 demonstrate that the 35-39 age category includes the highest number of residents, followed closely by the 30-34 and the 40-44 age categories.

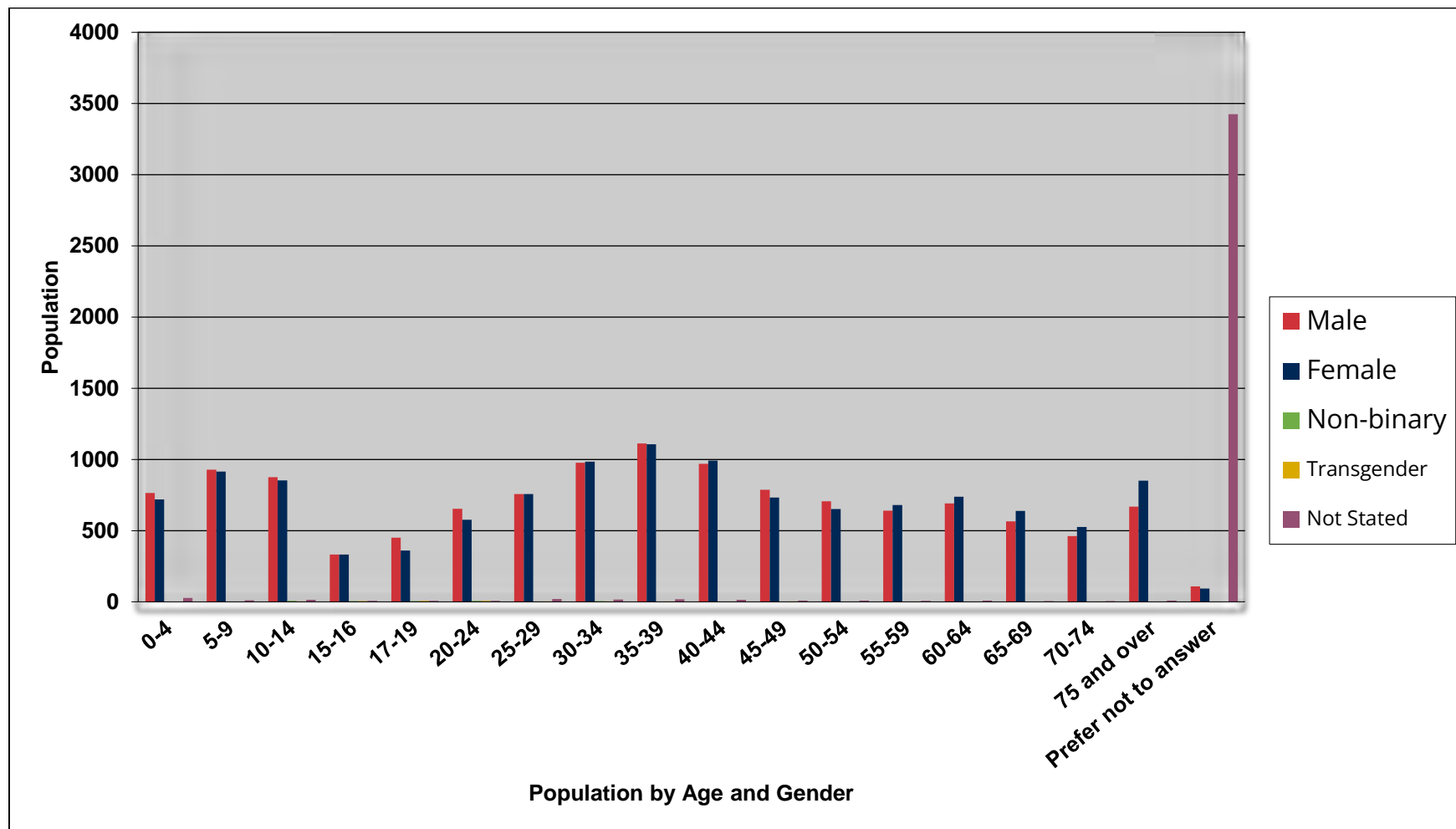

Dwelling Type

Single detached houses remain the predominant type of dwelling in Fort Saskatchewan (Table 7). Apartments, duplexes, and row houses are the next popular dwelling types for Fort Saskatchewan. Vacant dwellings were recorded at 362 (Table 6) and there was a total of 1209 no responses (Not stated and preferred not to answer) for this question.

Figure 2. Employment Status

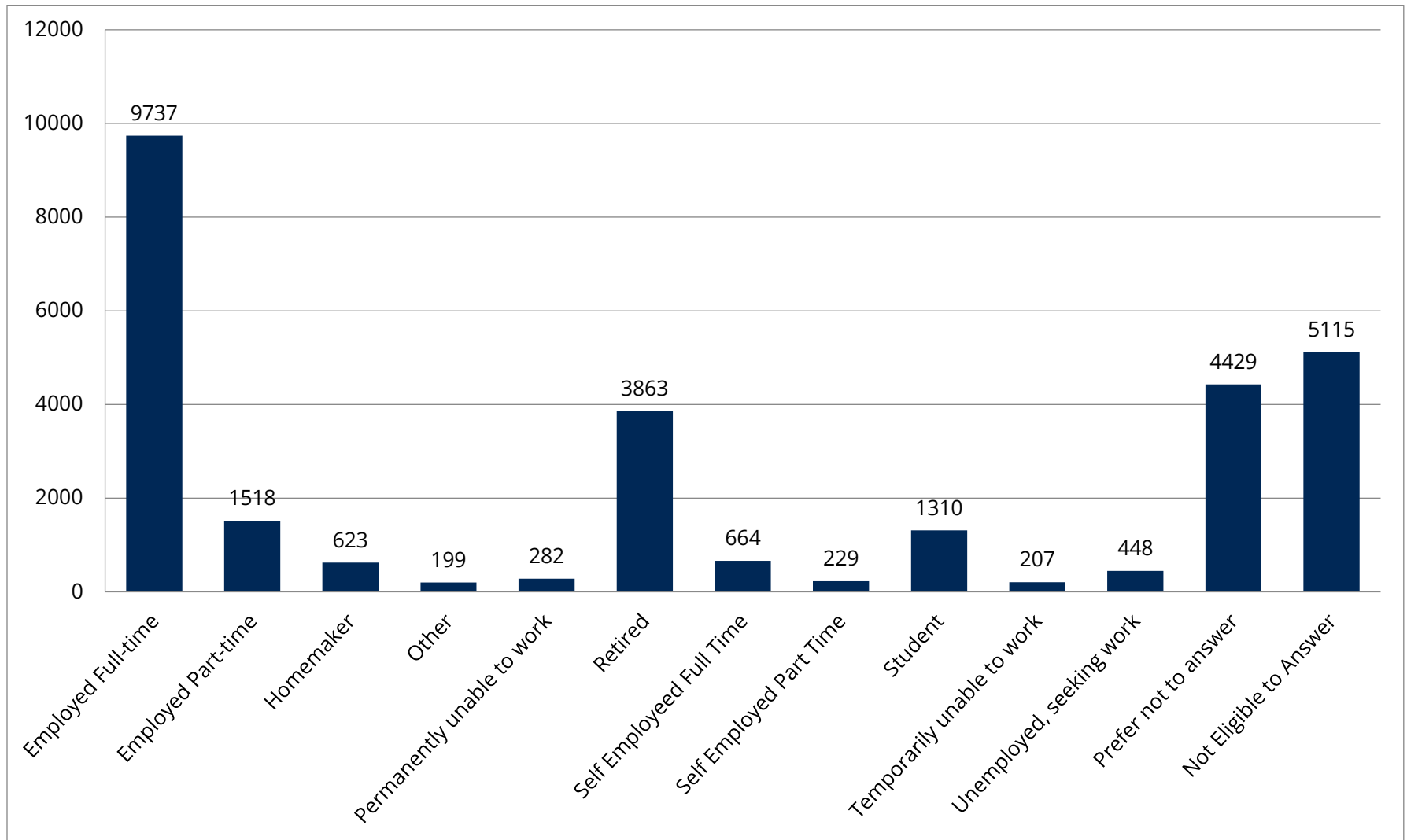


Figure 3. Employment Status by Gender

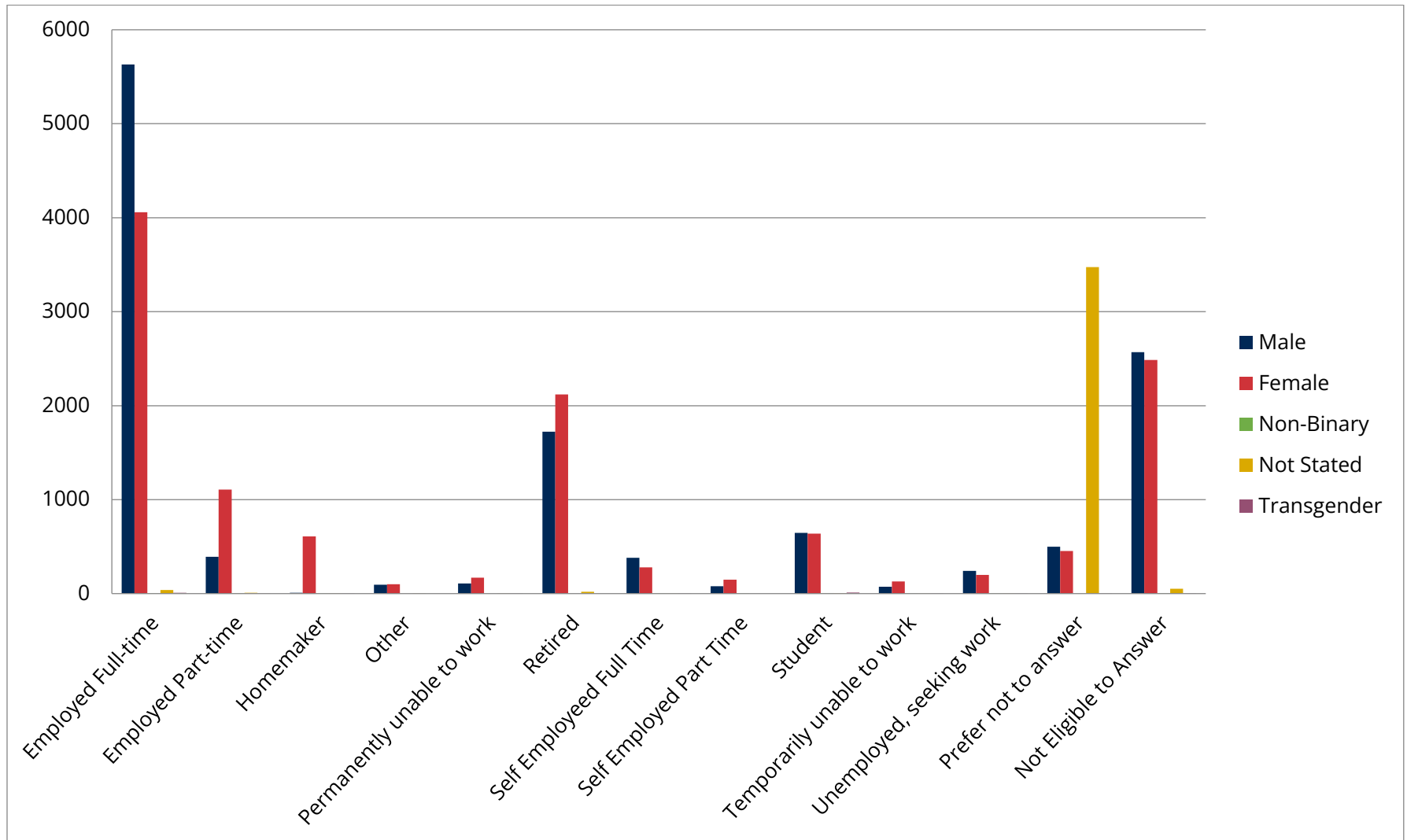
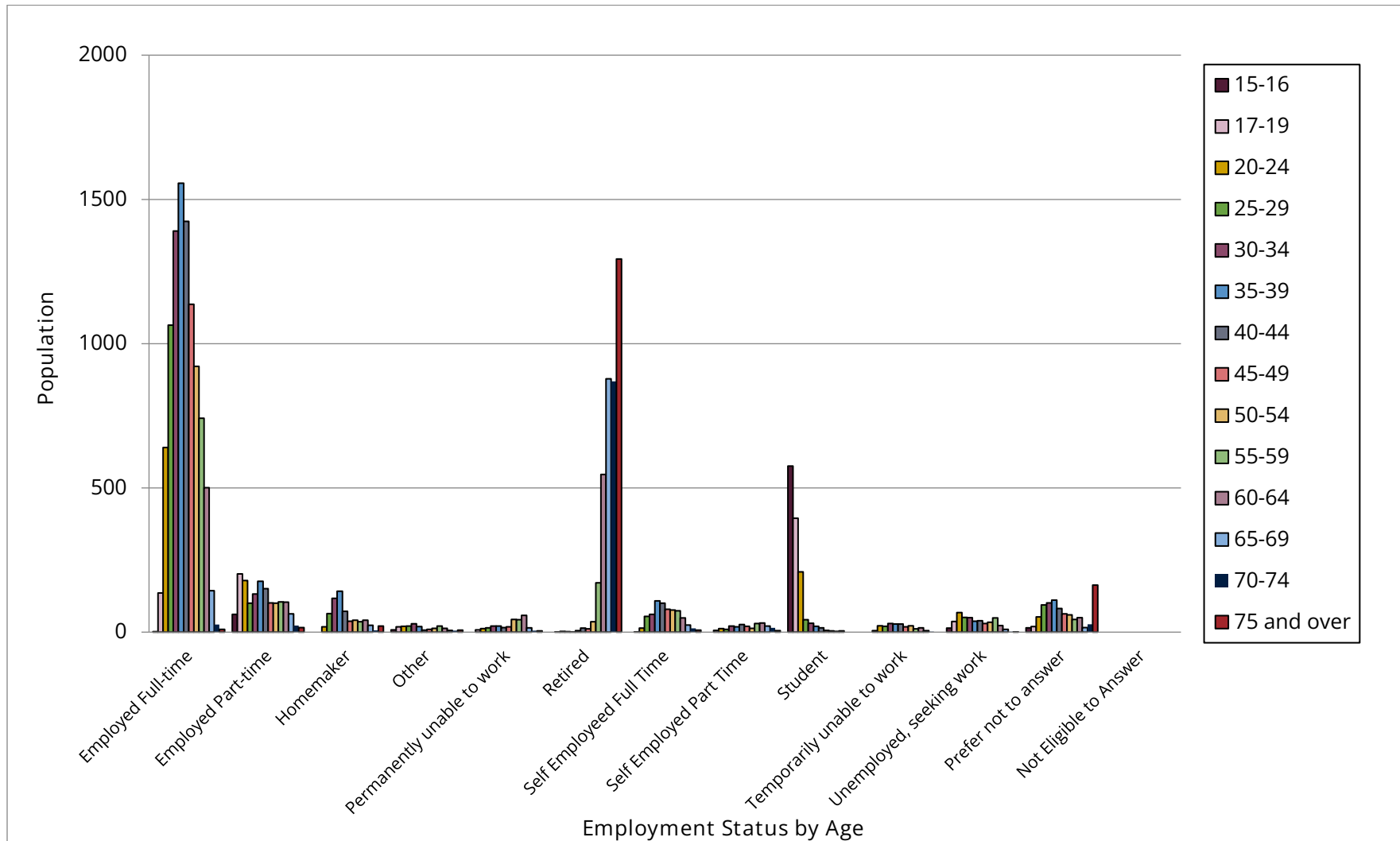

Figure 5. Employment Location

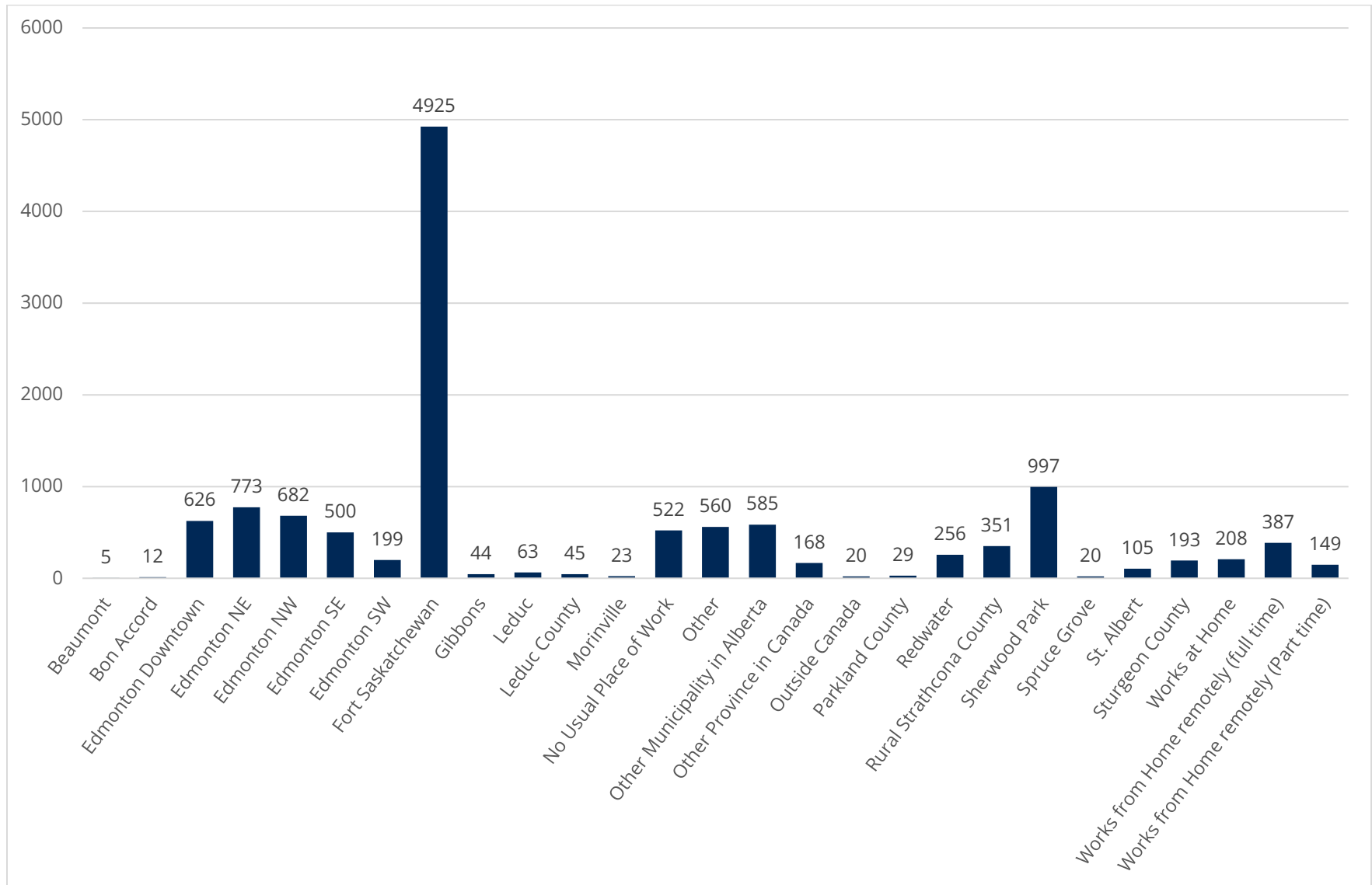


Figure 6. Employment Location by Gender

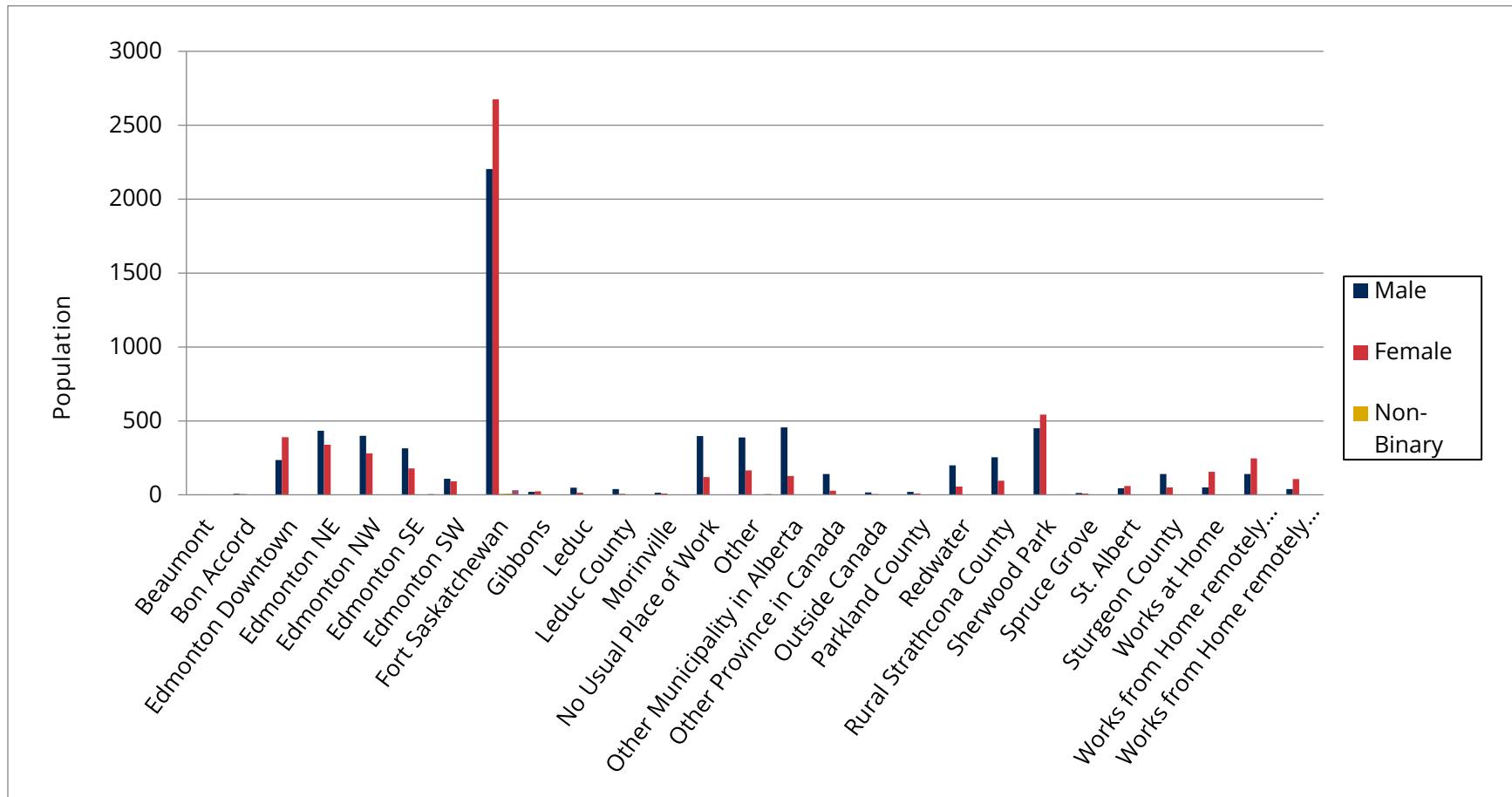

Figure 7. Main Mode of Transportation

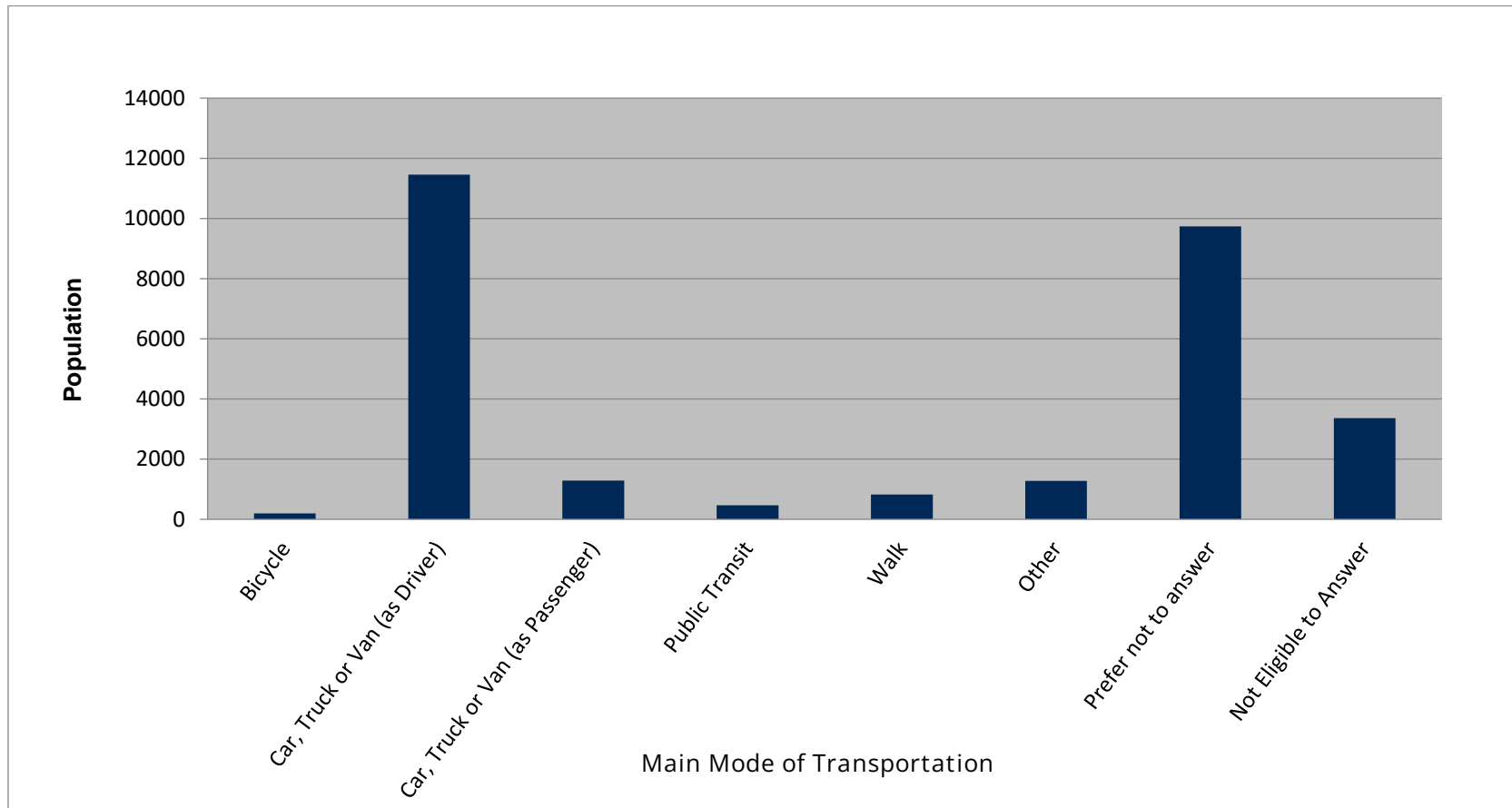


Figure 8. Main Mode of Transportation by Gender

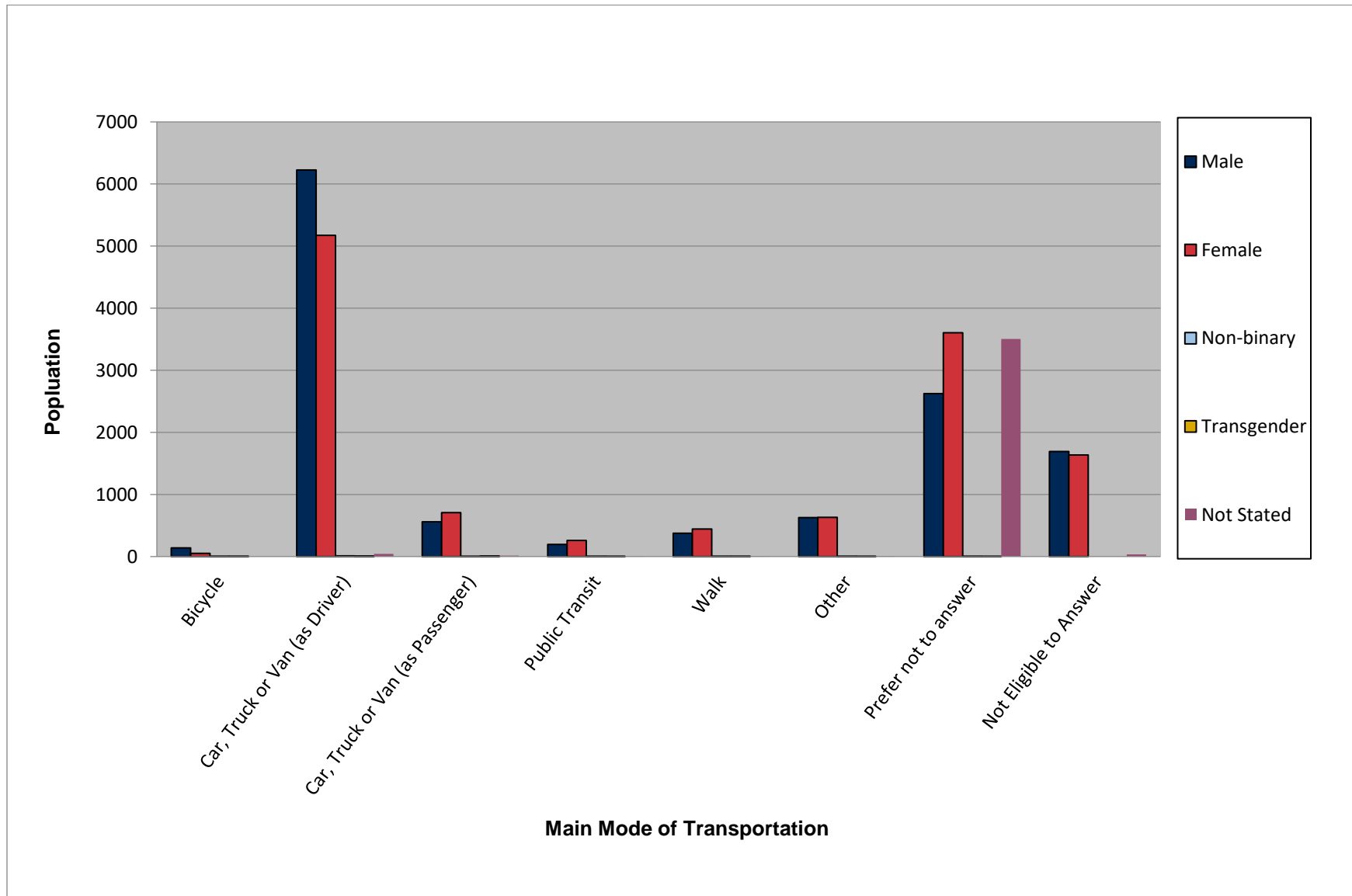
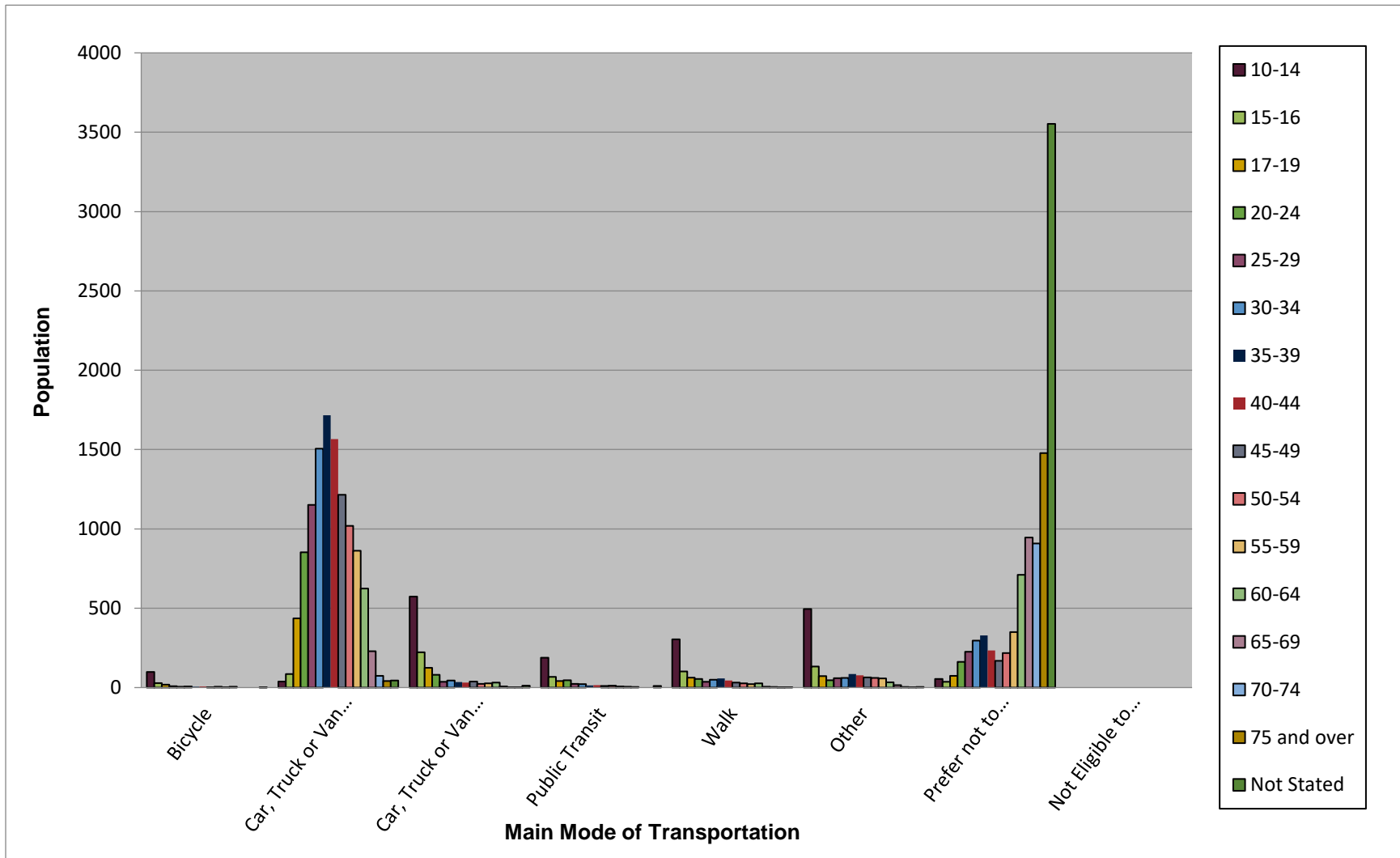

Figure 10. Length of Residency

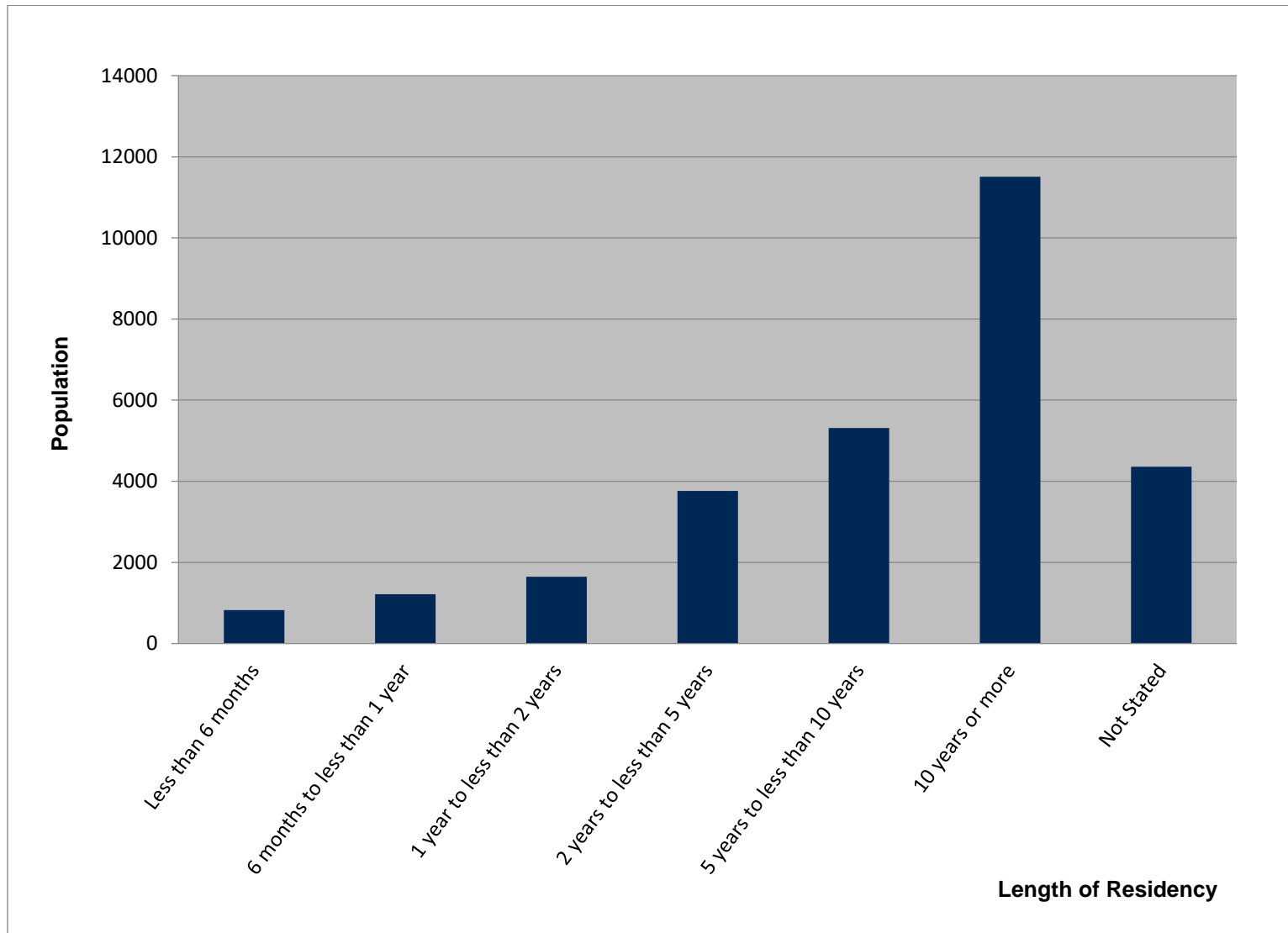


Figure 11. Length of Residency by Gender

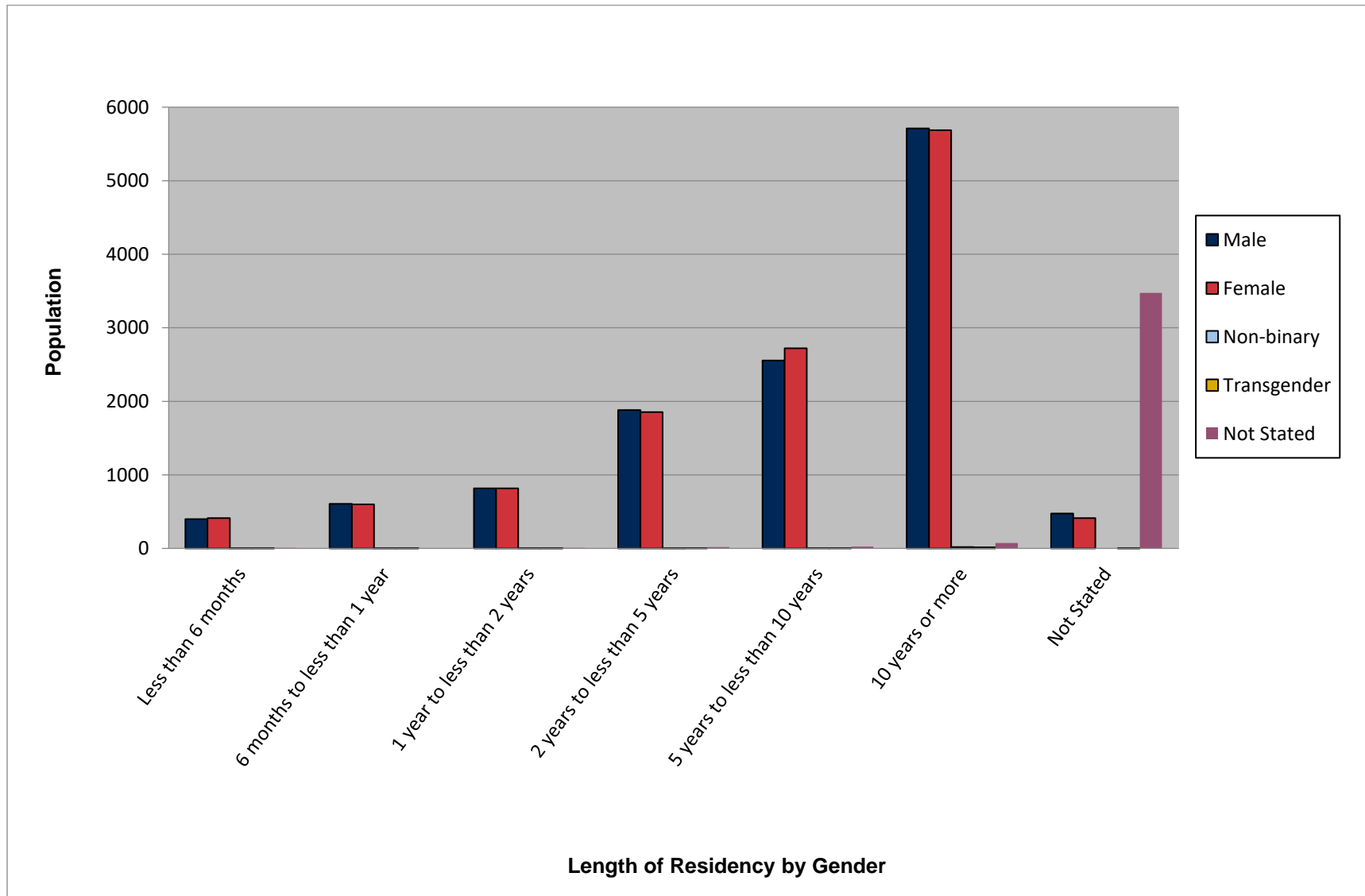
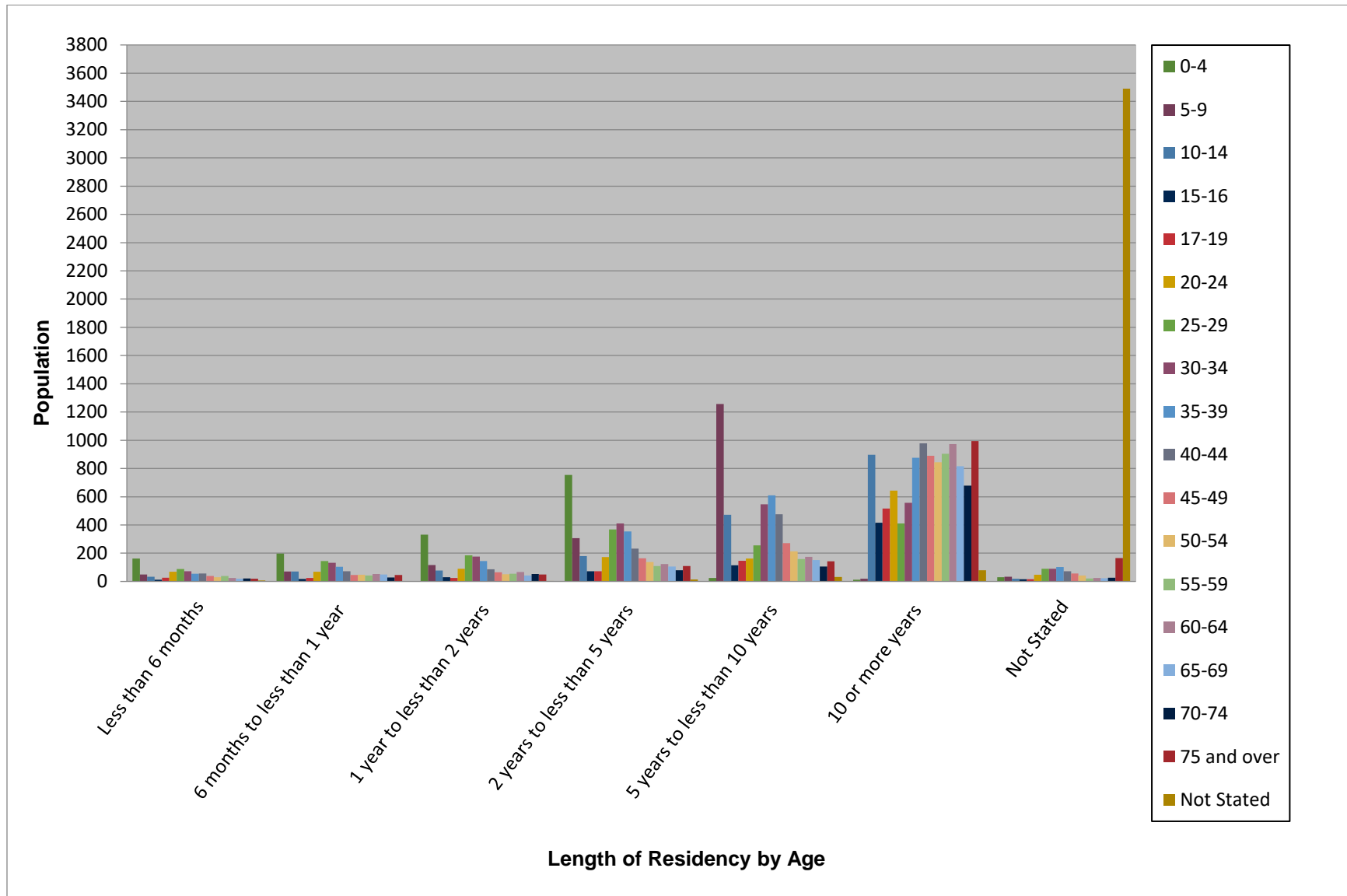

Figure 13. Level of Education

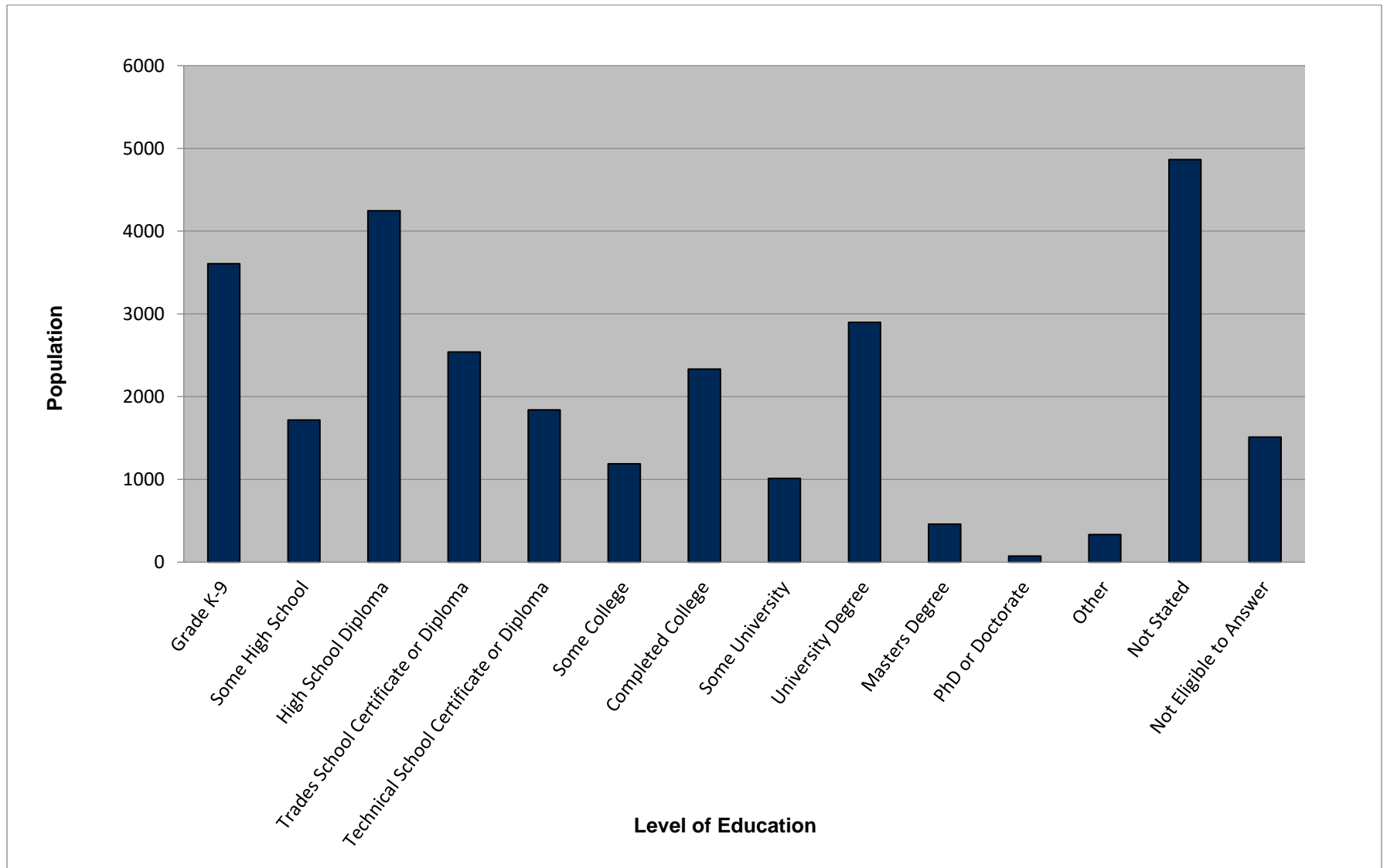


Figure 14. Level of Education by Gender

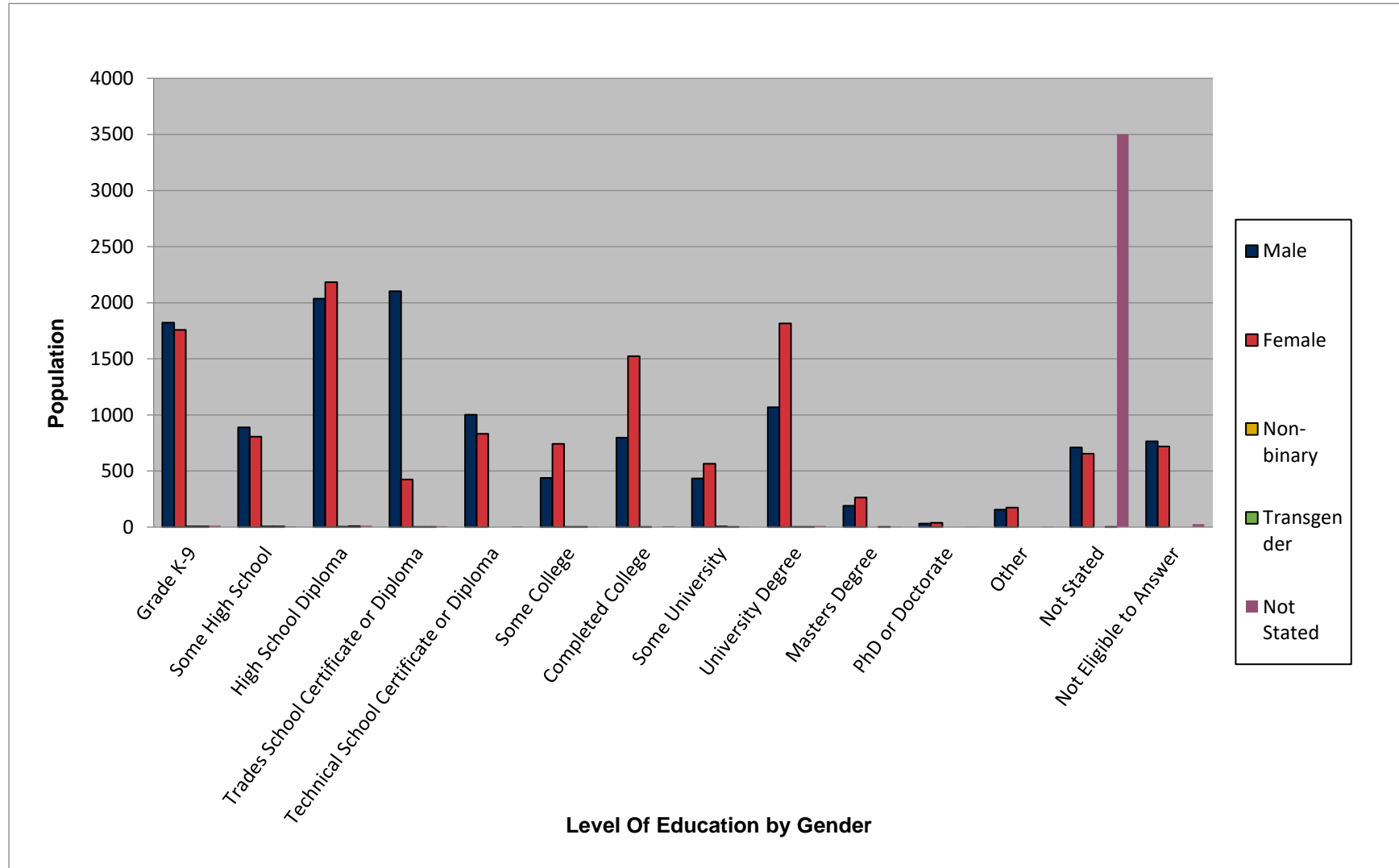
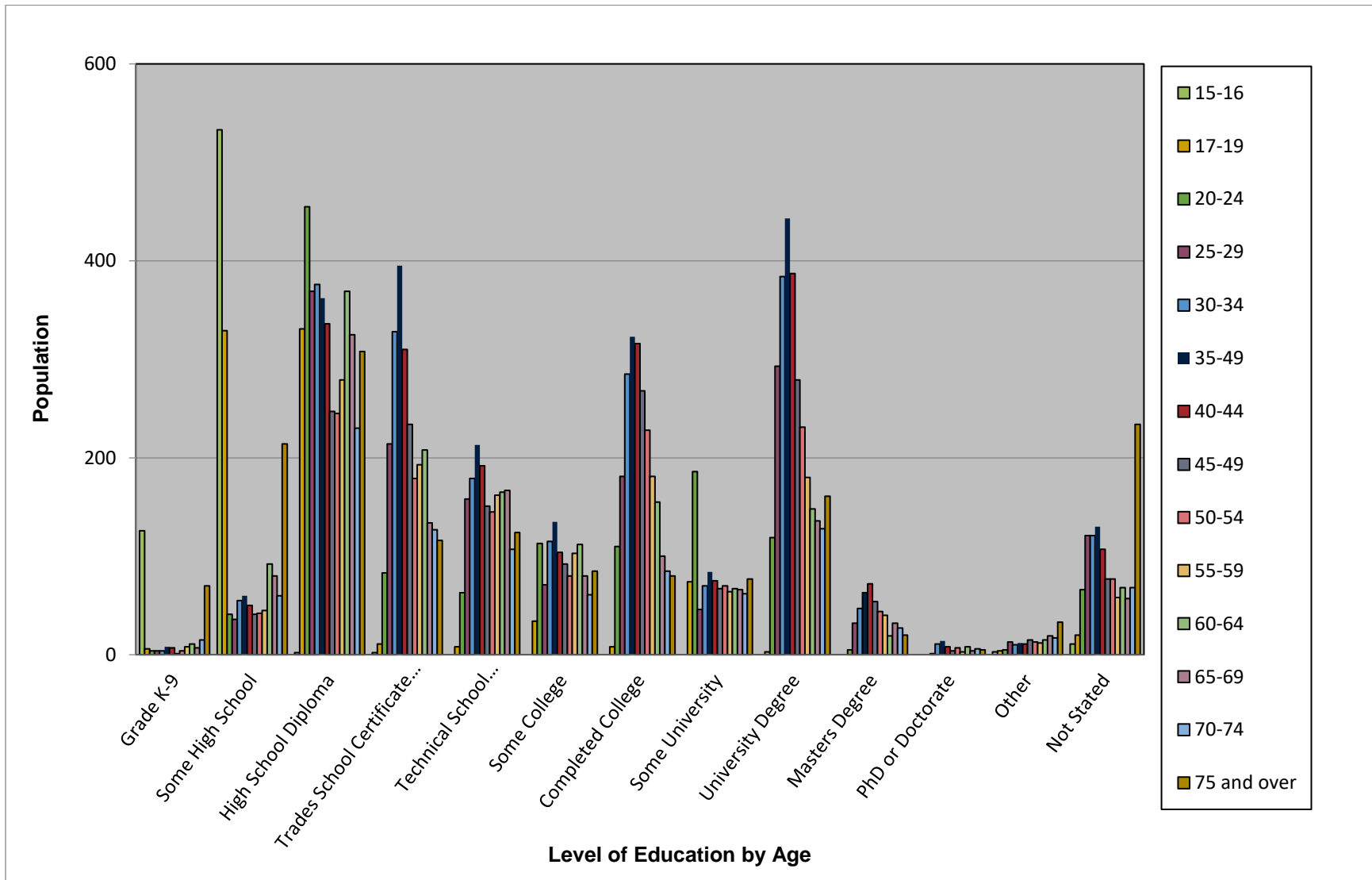

Figure 16. Language Spoken at Home

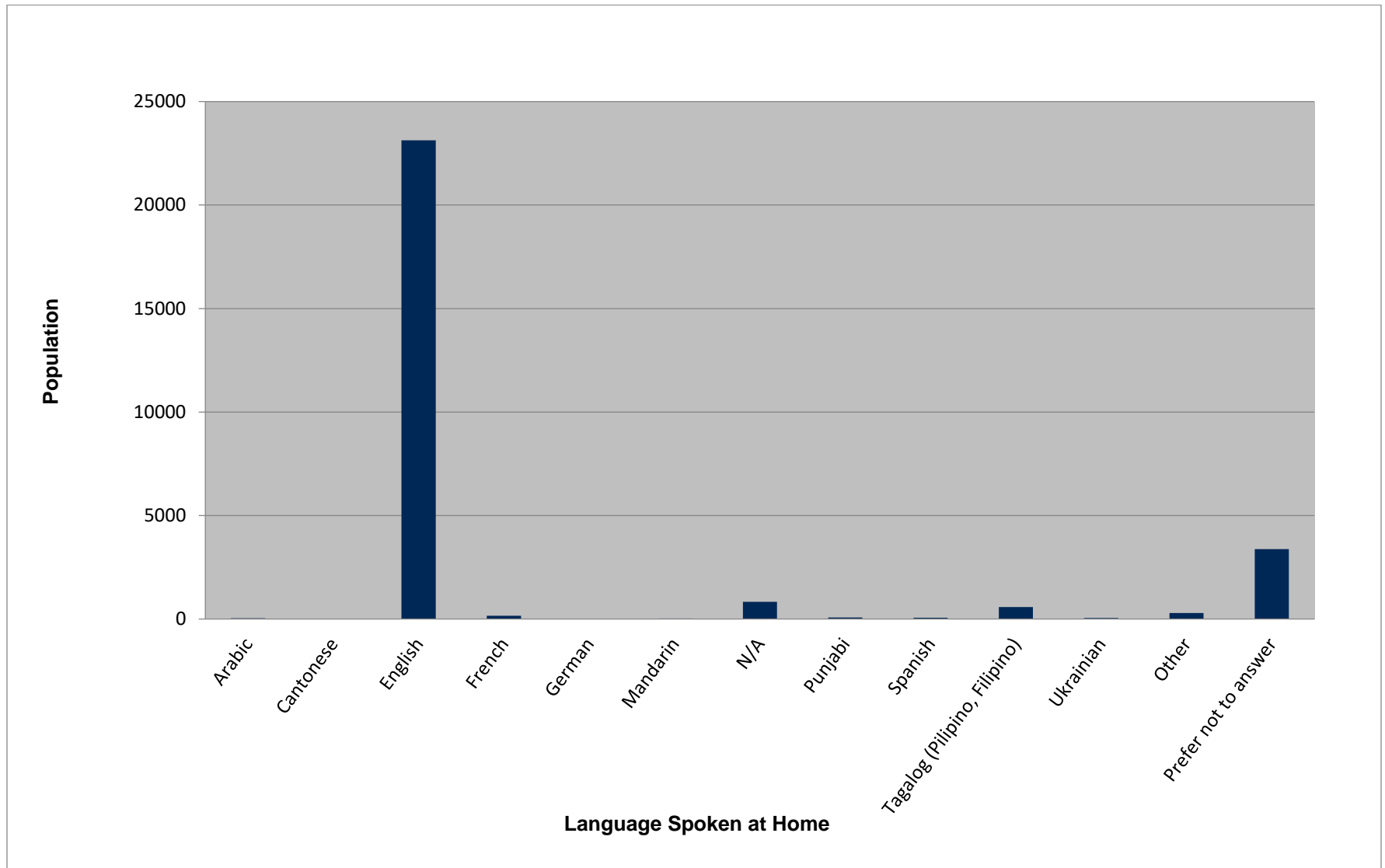


Figure 17. Language Spoken at Home by Gender

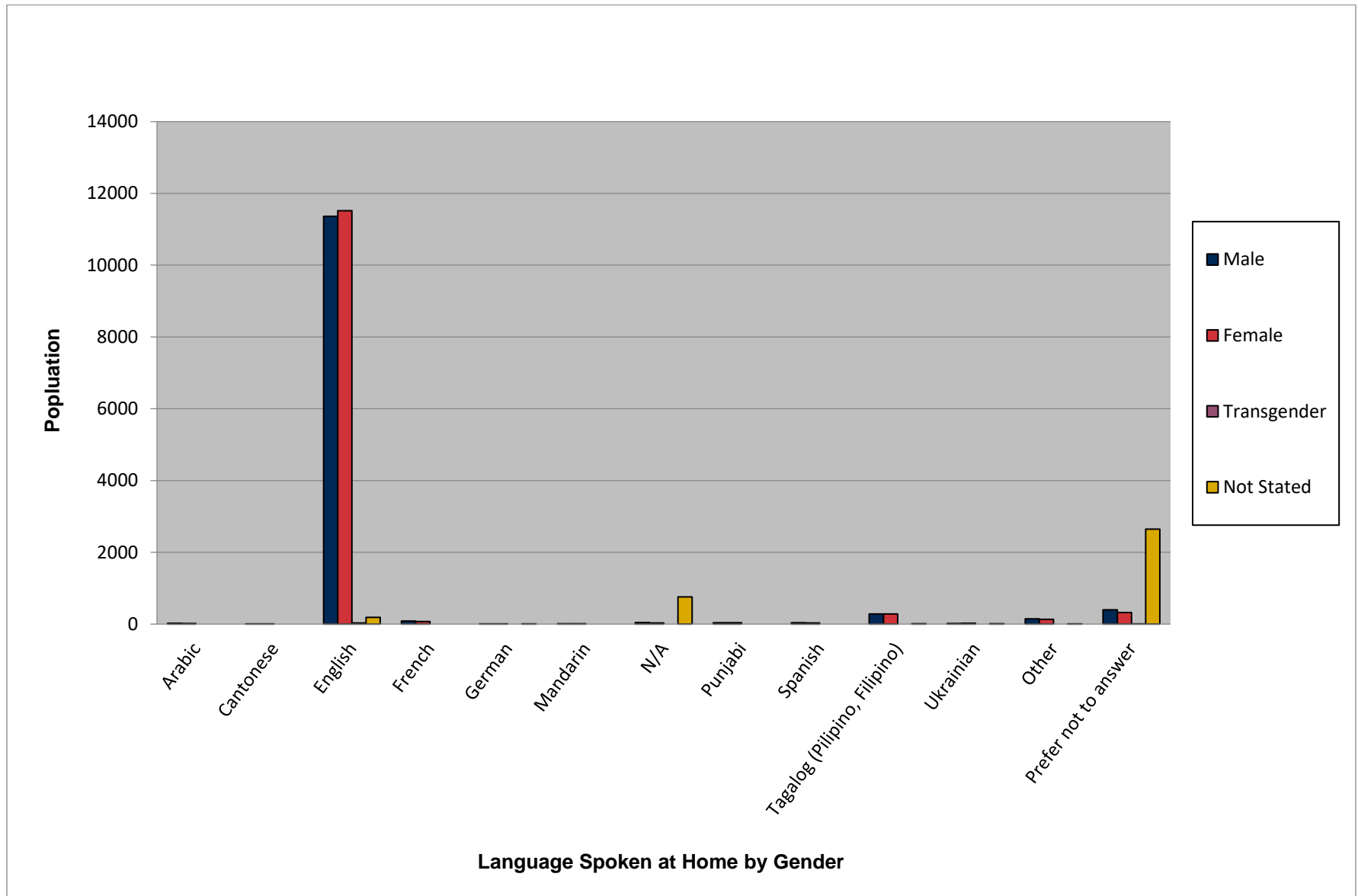
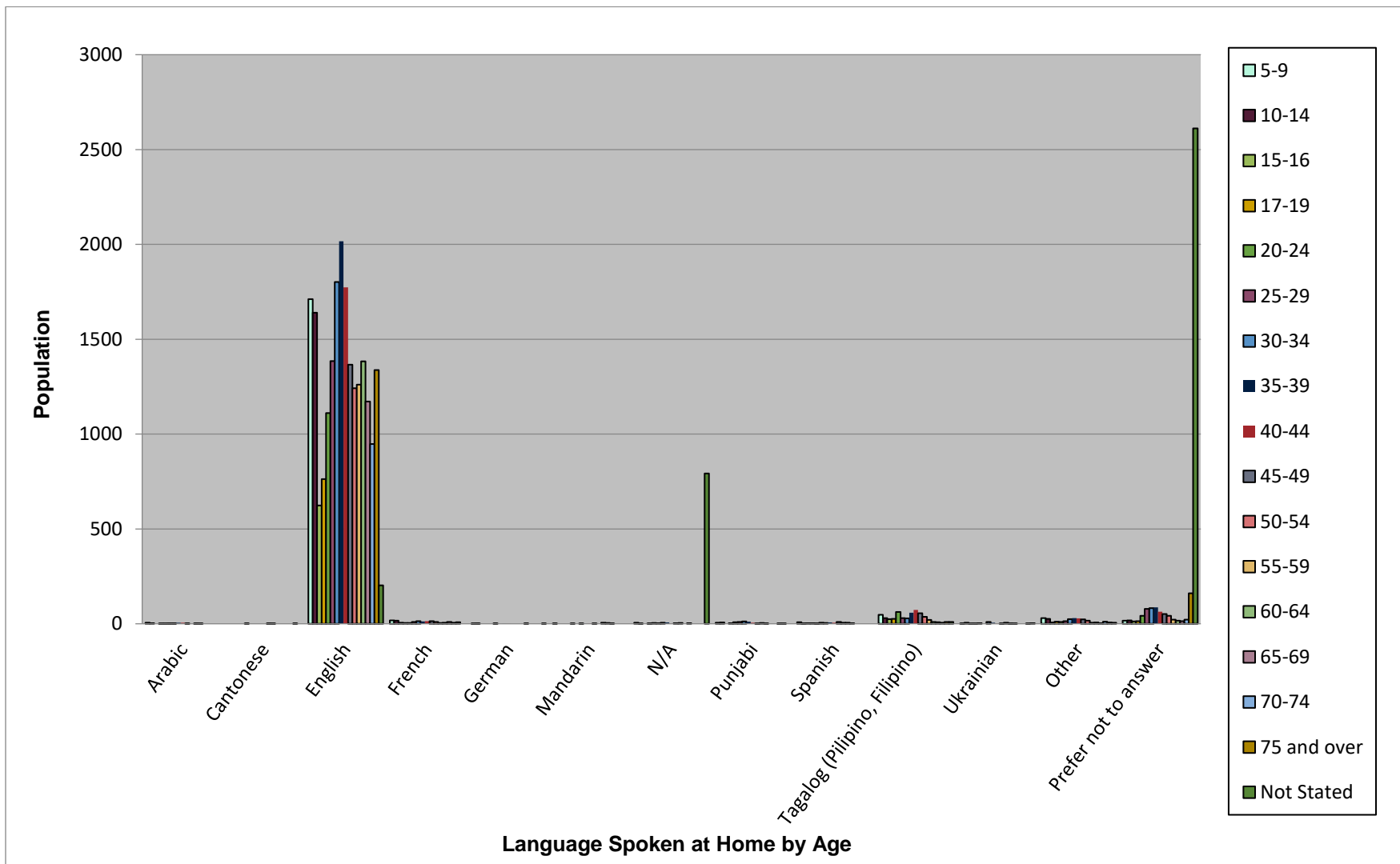

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Figure 19. Population by Enumeration Area (101-308)

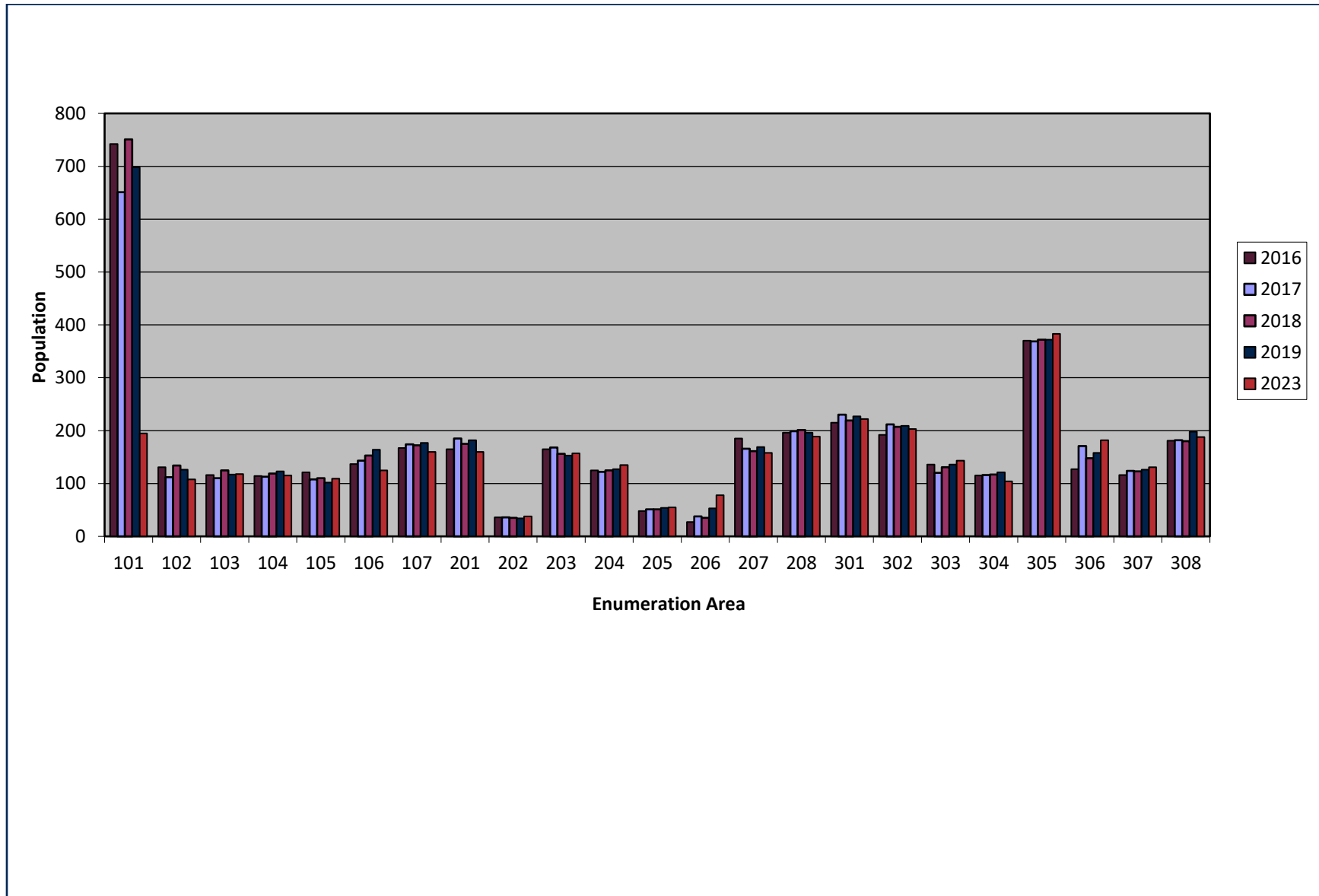


Figure 20. Population by Enumeration Area (309-507)

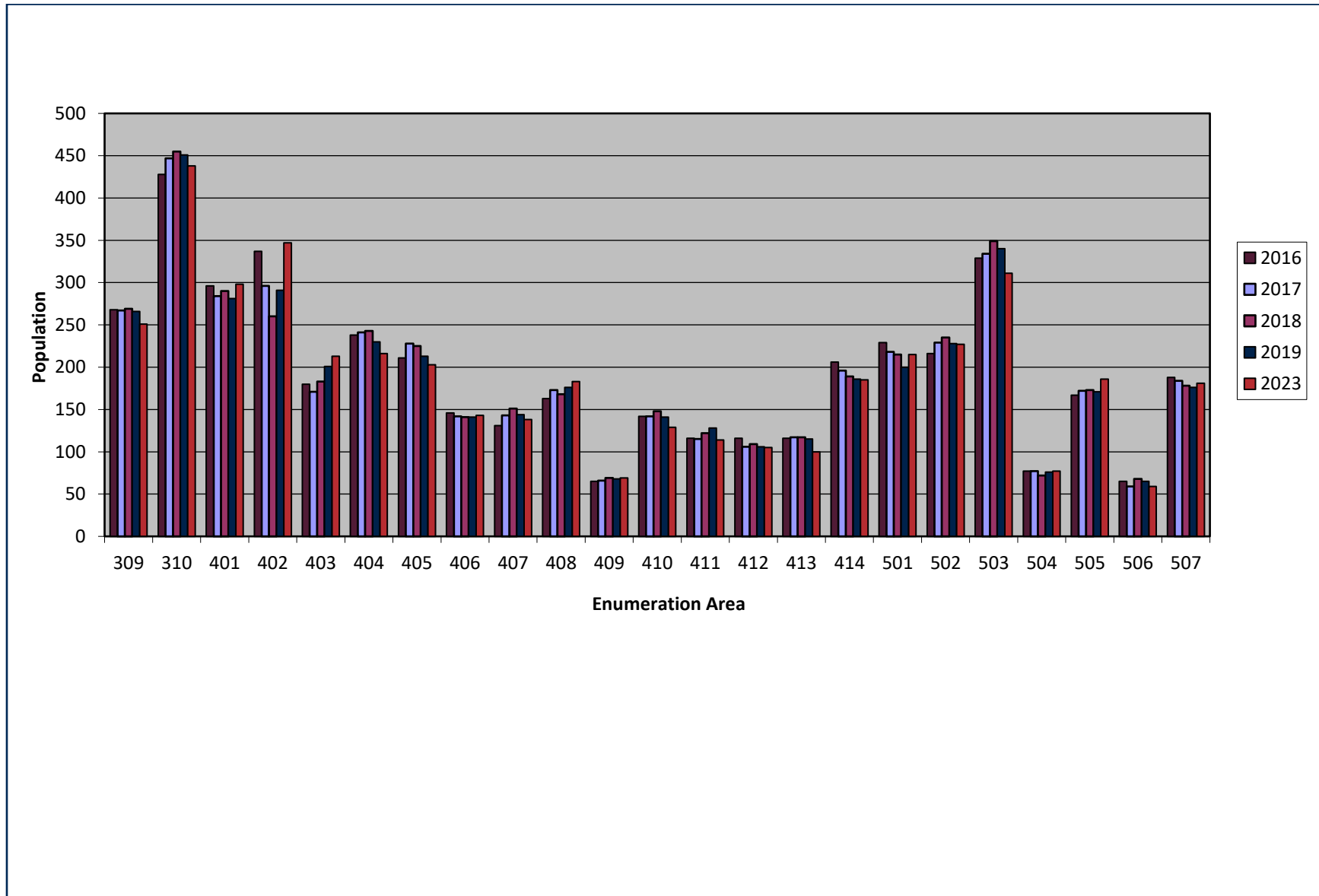


Figure 21. Population by Enumeration Area (508-709)

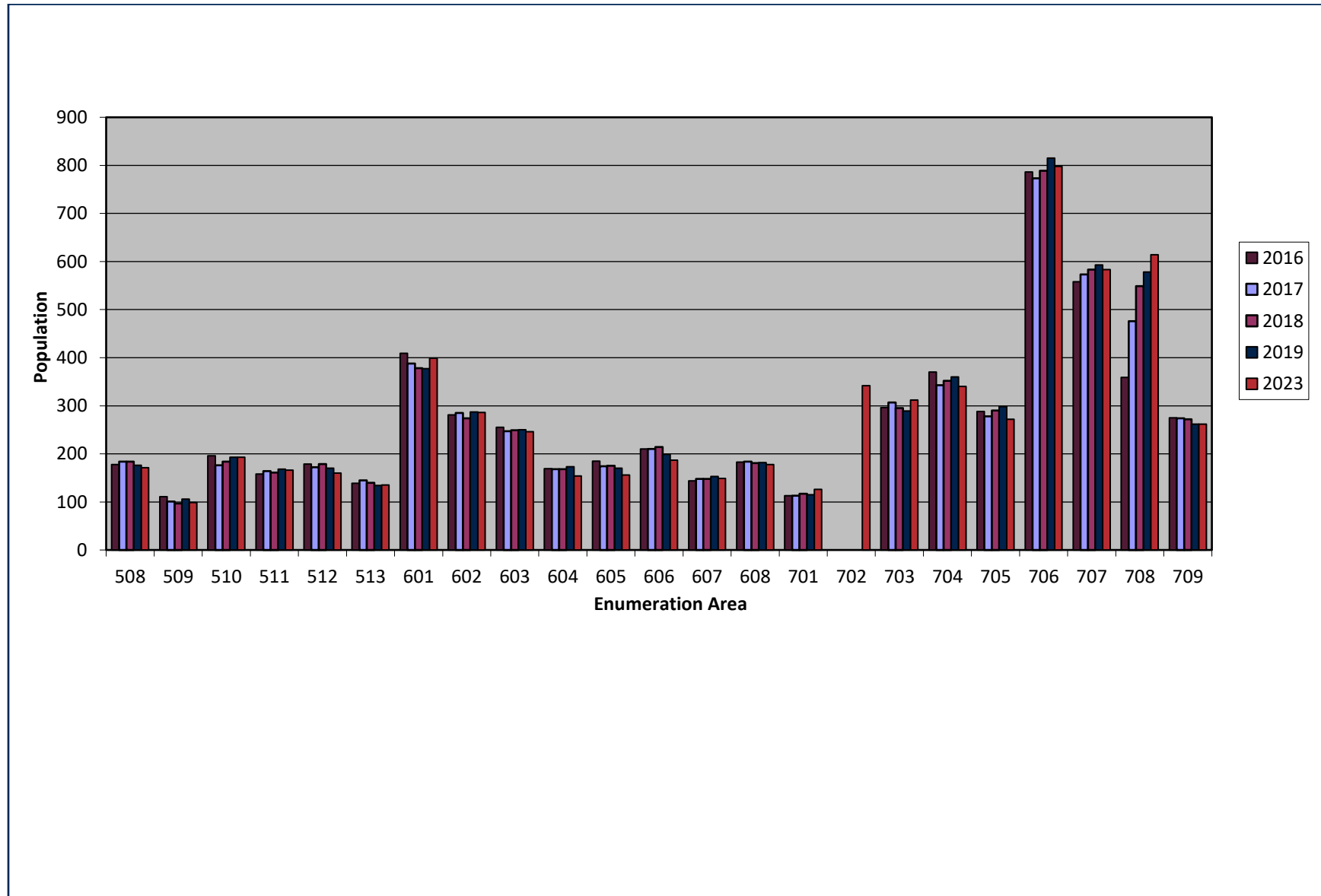
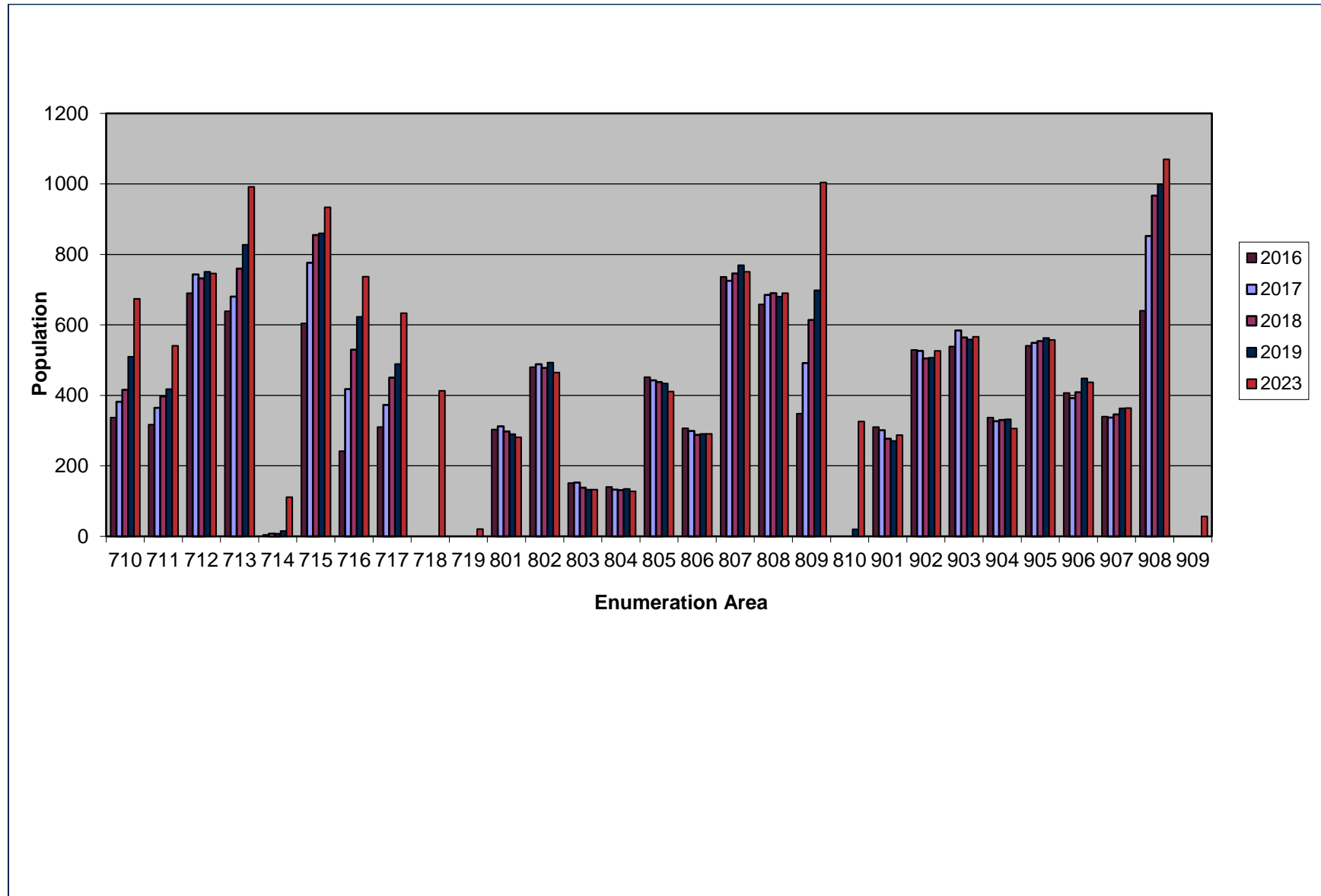
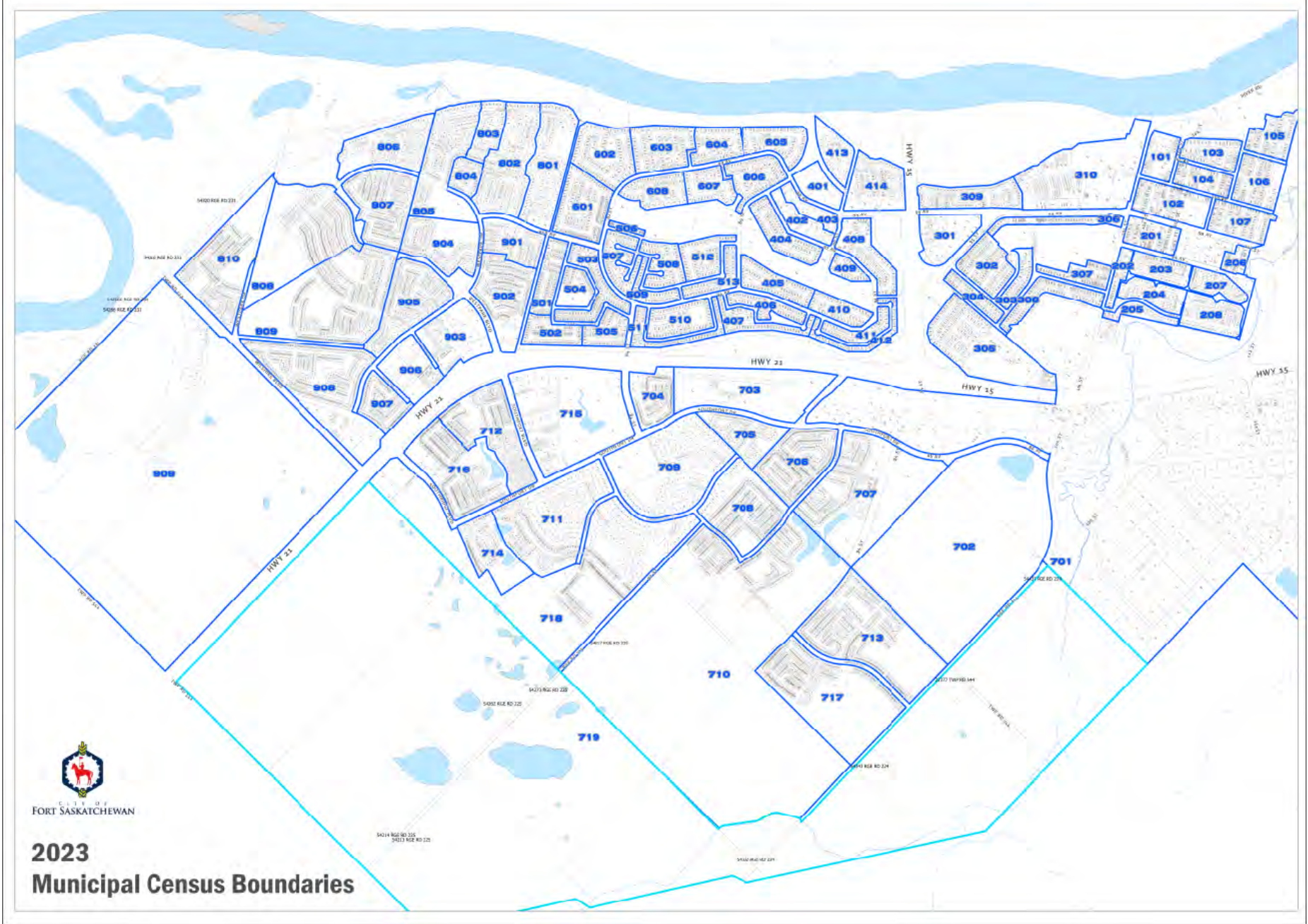


Figure 22. Population by Enumeration Area (710-909)





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
