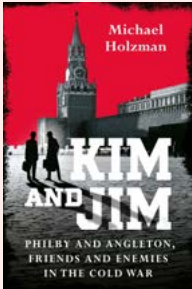
The Octopus Man tells the story of Tom, once an outstanding law student, now lost in the machinery of the British mental health system.

Simone de Beauvoir borrowed her lover's bike to cycle around Paris in the 1940s. Alice Hawkins used her bicycle to recruit women to fight for women's suffrage. Many of these women were told they couldn't or shouldn't cycle, but they did so anyway. *Revolutions* introduces us to the women who are part of the rich and varied history of cycling, many of whom have been pushed to the margins or forgotten.
