
MEASURING GUIDE FOR STAIR PANELS.



To get the number of panels,

Divide the horizontal measurement by 285mm (11 $\frac{1}{4}$ inches) If you are left with an odd bit to fill, use our fill in panels.

To get the number of joint/end strips,

You need 1 cut length of joint strip between each pair of stair panels, and at each end a cut length of joint or end strip. Remember you should get 3 cut lengths from each 2435mm (8 foot) full length.

To get the number of dado rails,

Measure the diagonal (i.e. along the slope) of the staircase, add 50mm (2 inches) for the angled cut, and multiply by 2.

Then, divide the total by 2435mm (the length of our dado rails). Make sure you round up for quantities
