Colonel Kathleen M. Hasson is the Commander, 305th Air Mobility Wing, Joint Base McGuire-Dix-Lakehurst, New Jersey. The 305 AMW utilizes 22 KC-46 Pegasus and 14 C-17 Globemaster III aircraft to provide global mobility support for national security objectives, combat operations, contingencies, and humanitarian relief efforts worldwide through aerial refueling and airland capabilities. The 305 AMW is also responsible for two of Air Mobility Command's busiest aerial ports ensuring uninterrupted flow of forces and material in support of ongoing global operations, and two airfields in Air Mobility Command's most complex airspace, while providing logistical support to the Joint Base community.

Col Hasson earned her commission as a graduate with military distinction from the United States Air Force Academy in 2000. She has deployed in support of Operations Northern Watch, Enduring and Iraqi Freedom. Col Hasson has held positions at the squadron, group, wing,



and headquarters level. She is a command pilot with over 2,500 hours, primarily in the C-17 and over 1,000 combat hours. She has joint experience at Allied Joint Force Command, Naples, Italy, and an Air Operations Command tour in the 613 AOC, JB PHH, Hawaii, where she served as Chief, Air Mobility Division.
