### **NONJUDICIAL PUNISHMENTS (ART 15)**

UCMJ Violation	Member's Rank	Imposed Punishment
<i>1 - Article 107—False Official Statement</i>	SrA	Reduction to E-3 (suspended), forfeitures of \$250.00 pay per month for 2 months, and a reprimand
<i>1- Article 113—Drunken Operation of a Vehicle</i>	Amn	Reduction to E-1 and a reprimand
<i>1-Article 92—Failure to Obey</i> <i>1-Article 112a -Wrongful use of Sched I,II,III drug</i>	SrA	Reduction to E-3 and a reprimand
<i>1- Article 112a—Wrongful use of Marijuana</i>	A1C	Reduction to E-1 and a reprimand

*UCMJ Art. 15 allows for Commanding officers to offer non-judicial punishment in lieu of trial by court-martial, for violations of the UCMJ. If the forum is accepted by the member, the commander may impose punishment should they determine an offense under the UCMJ was committed by the member.*
