To be considered eligible for a Kerner Scholar, a student must meet all of the following criteria:

- 1. be a second semester Junior (at least 70 hours completed);
- 2. have been accepted as a major by the Department of History;
- 3. attend the university on a full-time basis (at least 12 hours per semester) in the year of the award;
- 4. complete at least one upper-division History course each semester in the year of the award;
- 5. have achieved a cumulative grade-point average of 3.5 and no less than a 3.5 in History courses;
- 6. complete the one page statement referred to below.
- 7. The Kerner Scholarship applies to a student's tuition. Students who have some combination of tuition exchange and scholarships may not be eligible, or may see an award adjusted so that it doesn't exceed tuition costs, subject to confirmation from the Office of Financial Aid.

In the Spring semester of each academic year, the Department of History will select up to two History majors as KERNER SCHOLARS. Each KERNER SCHOLAR will receive an award up to \$4,200 to be applied to tuition the following year.
