YY: Denotes last two digits of the year (eg. 11 = 2011)

WW: Denotes week number (eg. 39 = week 39)

Rating label

Identification

- Kambrook Essentials Microwave Oven 30L (KMO400) purchased from Kmart stores nationally during 2008 to September 2013 with production date code (PDC) 833 to 1321 inclusive.
- The model number 'KMO400' is printed on the rating label on the back of the appliance.
- The PDC can be located on or near the rating label (see above diagram). This will be a 3 or 4 digital number.
- If there is no PDC number on or near the rating label, refer to the first 4 digits of the serial number.
