SYLLABUS Adobe Photoshop and Adobe Premiere Grade 8 Mr. P.C. Williams LHMS

Course Description: The purpose of this course is to provide insight into the mechanics of operating a digital camera as well as knowledge of software (Adobe PhotoShop) used to manipulate photographs. Students will learn basic photography skills, including, but not limited to: modifying aperture, adjusting shutter speed, and setting appropriate ISO. In addition to our photography section, students will create a video short in Adobe Premiere.
