

## **Pointe Coupee 4-H Shooting Sports Attendance Agreement Form**



All students <u>MUST</u> complete <u>8</u> hours of practice in each/any discipline they choose to compete prior to being eligible to compete in any Regional, State, or National competition. A 4-H certified discipline instructor will verify the completion on registration forms and a certified instructor will validate the registration forms for the events.

You are required to make sure your child signs in at every practice that they attend to receive credit for their hours. It is not the instructor's responsibility to do a roll call at practices.

All 4-H shooters that are 10 years of age and older prior to 1/1/21 MUST complete a Hunter Safety course after they turn 10 years of age, but prior to February 1, 2021.
