# 2024 Liberty Rating

for the New Hampshire

House & Senate



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This is the annual Liberty Rating issued by the New Hampshire Liberty Alliance, based on 108 roll call votes in the House and 30 in the Senate along with one synthetic roll call due to the poor record of the Senate of going on the record. Individual grades for each representative and senator are based on pro-liberty or anti-liberty roll call votes and sponsorship/co-sponsorship for a subset of bills that have been included in our Gold Standard liberty voting guides distributed to Senators and Representatives each session day and/or our activist alert that goes out each week prior to public hearings. Each bill/vote is assigned an impact score by the NHLA considering the degree to which the bill or vote impacts (positively or negatively) liberty.

**Pro-liberty bills** protect individual freedom of choice and personal responsibility; recognize the superiority of freedom over coercion; respect the citizen's right of self-ownership; promote governance that is transparent, accountable, and adheres to the Constitution; and recognize the value of voluntary economic decisions.

**Anti-liberty bills** replace self-governance with interventionist regulation; assume rules made by agencies backed by force are superior to voluntary choices backed by personal accountability; and assume a better economy can be managed by a central authority that compels people and businesses to pay for policies they may not willingly support.

The Liberty Rating is the result of hundreds of hours of work by many volunteers who have read and analyzed bills, testified before committees, called and written their representatives, worked on our other signature publication, the Gold Standard, and culled extensive data from legislative voting records. We encourage New Hampshire citizens to learn the facts about how their elected representatives are voting in Concord and to use this tool to hold them accountable. This report card serves as a valuable voter guide when these same representatives are running for re-election.

Motions of Ought to Pass (“**OTP**”), Ought to Pass with Amendment (“**OTP/A**”), and to accept a Committee of Conference report (“C of C”) pass a bill. If we recommended yea on these motions, it was a pro-liberty bill; if nay, it was an anti-liberty bill. Motions of Inexpedient to Legislate (“**ITL**”), **Table**, or **Indefinitely Postpone** kill a bill. Interim Study (“**IS**”) will result in the matter being studied and effectively terminates the bill for this legislative session. If we recommended yea on these motions, it was an anti-liberty bill; if nay, it was a pro-liberty bill. Scores are based primarily on roll-call votes but also include a small modifier for sponsorship score.

## Legislator of the Year

The Honorable Emily Phillips represents district Rockingham-7 (Fremont).

Representative Phillips is a member of the Special Committee on Childcare. She previously has served on the school board and Fremont budget committee.

She was first elected as a state representative in 2022 and he has received an NHLA Liberty rating score of A+ for each session. In her short time in the NH House, she has risen to the role of Assistant Majority Leader.

In 2024, she has been endorsed by the NHLA for NH Senate District 23 - Brentwood, Chester, Danville, East Kingston, Epping, Fremont, Kingston, Kensington, Newton, Sandown, Seabrook, and South Hampton.



## Activist of the Year

Our Activist of the year is Jeremy Olson. Jeremy has been having an impact on NH politics since 2007. He is a former NH Liberty Alliance board member having served as research director 2008 –



2010 and 2012 – 2014. He has served as secretary of Citizens for Criminal Justice Reform – New Hampshire since its founding in 2011.

In recent years, Jeremy has reengaged with the liberty community at large. He has supported multiple NHLA bill review working sessions, testified at the state house, volunteered with other liberty organizations for phone banking activities, and volunteered for campaigns. In 2023, he was a member of the NH Republican State

Committee for Grafton County. He currently leads the monthly Merrimack Valley Porcupines event.

## Bills utilized for Sponsorship Scores

Sponsorship score acts as a capped modifier on the numeric roll call score for legislators. Bills must have appeared in the Activist Alert or Gold Standard to be considered for sponsorship scoring. Selected bills are assigned a raw impact weight based on the impact to liberty. Anti-Liberty bills have the full negative weight applied upon introduction. Pro-Liberty bills receive 1/3 of the weight for each step through the legislature - 1/3 for being introduced in a chamber, 1/3 for passing in chamber that bill was introduced and 1/3 for passing in the other chamber. Co-sponsors each receive half credit while the sponsor receives full credit. Finally, the impact of sponsorship score is capped at +- 5 points with the intent being to allow bill sponsorship to only have a modest impact on the final grade. Bill selection and weight is based on the content of the bill as it was initially submitted and the text and title may have changed since the time that the bill was submitted.
