MAJOR GENERAL DAVID S. EAGLIN

Major General David S. Eaglin is the Director of the Air and Cyberspace Operations, Pacific Air Forces, Joint Base Pearl Harbor-Hickam, Hawaii. His directorate is comprised of six divisions, two support squadrons, and the 613 Air and Space Operations Center. He is responsible to support the Pacific Air Forces Commander, the United States Pacific Command's Operations Center, and directing air operations in the Pacific Area of Responsibility, while leading 45,000 Airmen stationed in Japan, Korea, Alaska, and Guam.

General Eaglin was born in West Memphis, AR, and earned his commission upon graduating from the United States Air Force Academy in 1994. He graduated, with distinction, from Undergraduate Pilot Training at Columbus Air Force Base, Mississippi. General Eaglin has served as an F-15C instructor pilot, flight examiner, flight commander, assistant director of operations, chief of standardization and evaluation, operations officer, squadron commander, vice wing commander and wing commander.



General Eaglin has deployed in support of Operations NORTHERN WATCH, INHERENT RESOLVE and with an Air Forces Central Command theater security package. He is a command pilot with more than 2,900 flight hours. Prior to this assignment, General Eaglin served as the Commander, 18th Wing, Kadena Air Base, Japan, Deputy Commander, Seventh Air Force, Air Forces Korea, and Chief of Staff, Air Component Command, Osan Air Base, South Korea. He was responsible for training and equipping tactical air superiority forces; combat search and rescue forces; command and control platforms; aeromedical evacuation capability; and global mobility resources for contingency operations.
