Mr. Donald Fenton is the Command Historian, Headquarters Pacific Air Forces (PACAF), Hickam AFB, Hawaii. He is responsible for establishing policy and overseeing the command's history, museum and art programs for three numbered air forces and ten wings located at Air Force installations in Alaska, Guam, Hawaii, Japan and Korea. He also manages the readiness of assigned PACAF historians to support contingency and humanitarian operations within the command.

Mr. Fenton entered the Air Force in January 1987 and attended the Air Force Basic Military Training School at Lackland AFB, Texas. In November 1999, he cross-trained into the Air Force History and Museums Program. He has deployed several times throughout his career as a historian in support of Operations SOUTHERN WATCH, ENDURING FREEDOM, and IRAQI FREEDOM.

Mr. Fenton retired from active duty in 2007 and entered civil service that same year. In addition to the education listed below, he has also completed post-graduate coursework in history with the University of Alaska, Fairbanks.
