


# PRE-REQUISITES

# WHAT'S MORE IN IT?

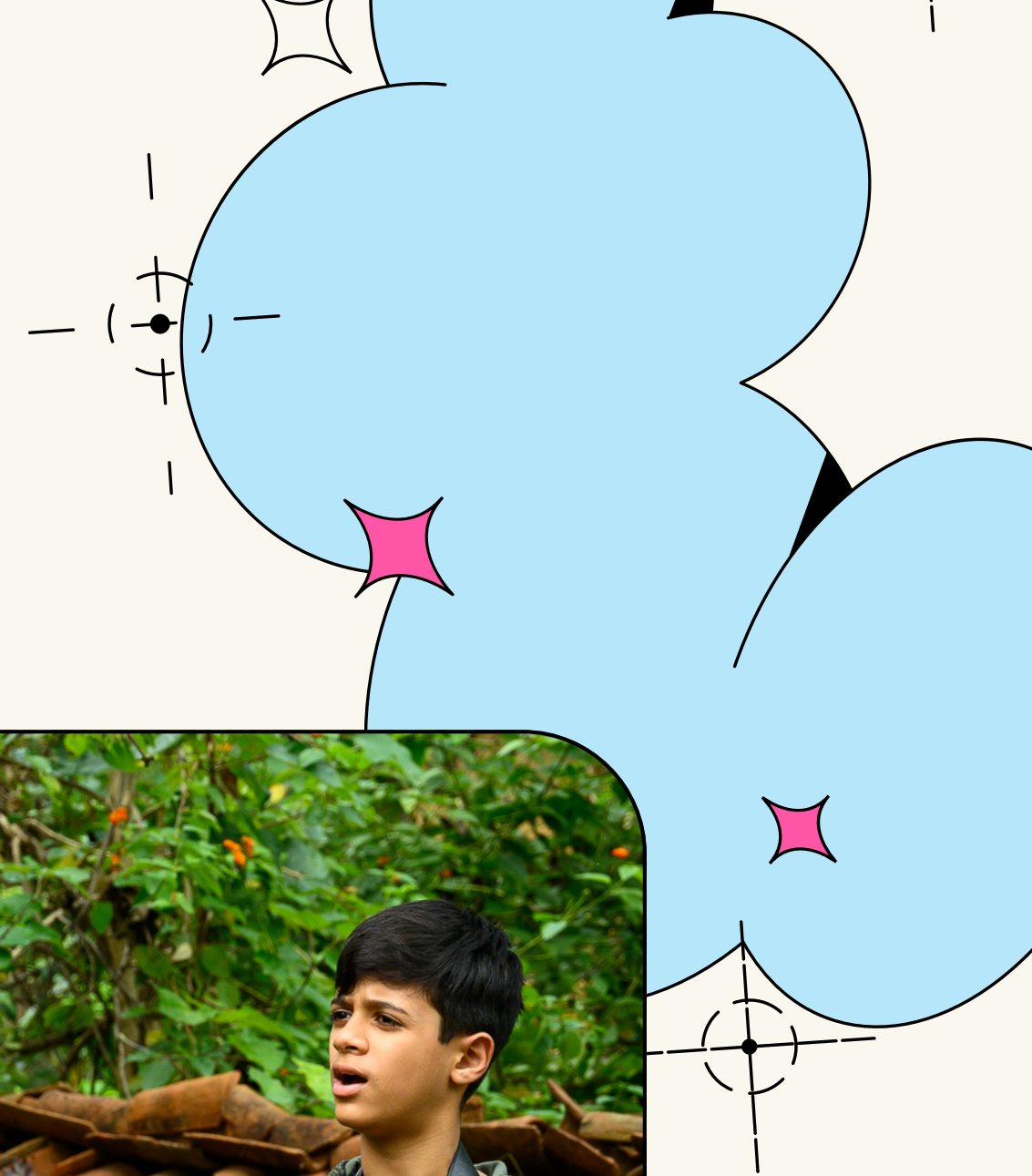
Building a foundation for a lifelong appreciation

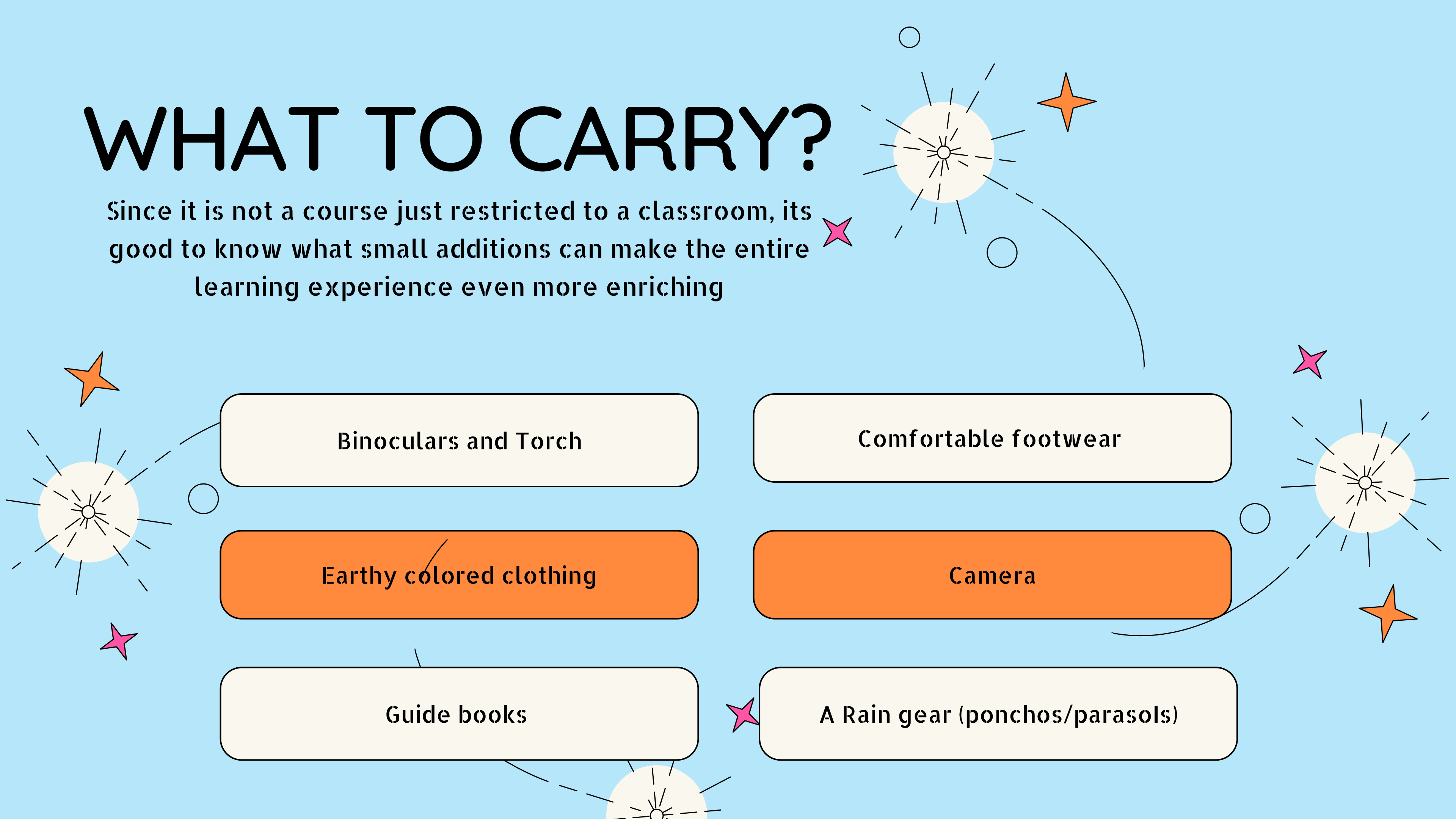

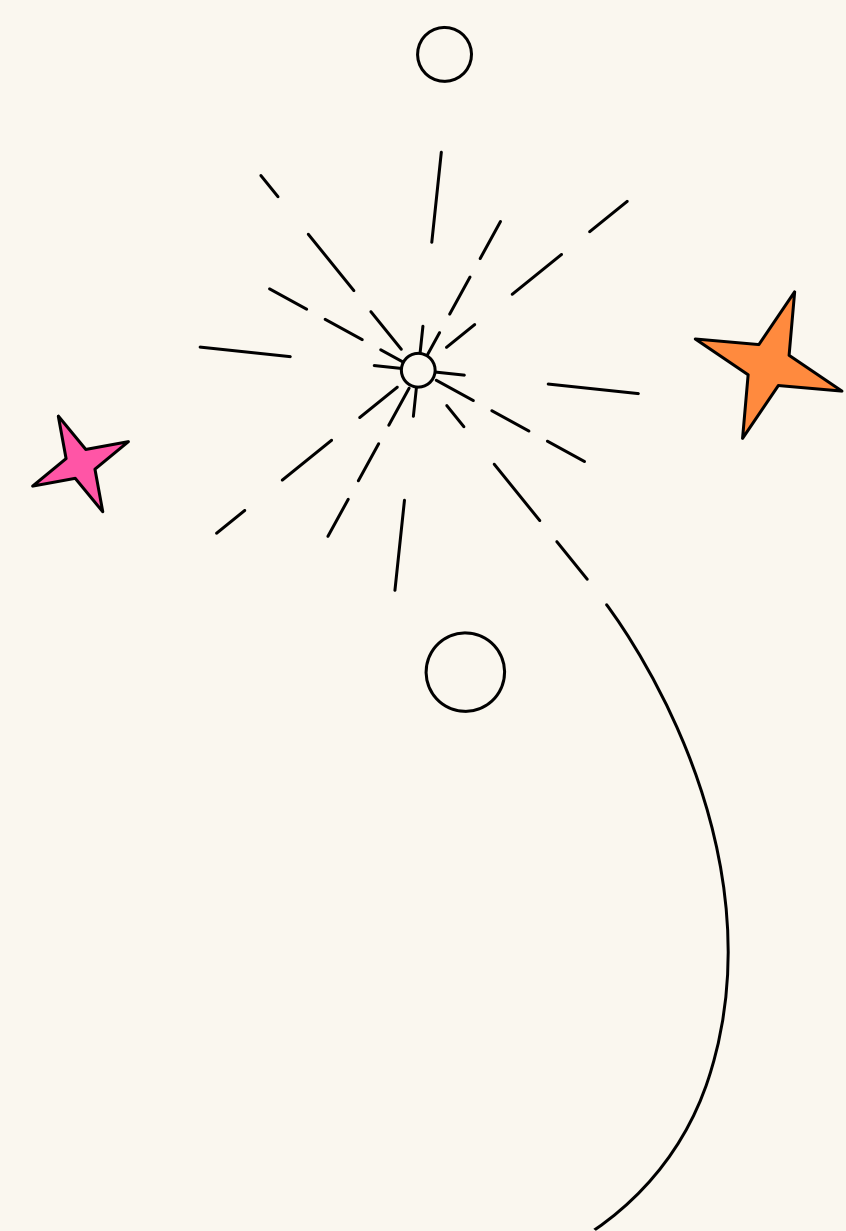
