

Diploma Supplement

The Diploma Supplement is a document issued to graduates of higher education institutions and it provides a description of the nature, level, context, content and status of the studies that were pursued and completed. It was developed jointly by UNESCO and the Council of Europe.

The purpose of the Diploma Supplement is to make the degree/diploma qualification more easily understood, especially for employers and institutions outside the issuing country.

The Diploma Supplement does not replace the official Degree Parchment or Transcript of Academic Records issued by RIAM. It does not guarantee recognition of the qualification.

The Diploma Supplement is automatically sent to RIAM diploma and degree graduates.
