

The fourth grade teachers would like to welcome you. You are now fourth graders. Next year will be an exciting fun-filled school year! We hope that all will enjoy their summer vacation and are ready for school again in August. Please visit the public libraries in Aberdeen and Ripley for the summer reading program and practice those multiplication times tables.

Fourth grade is departmentalized, so it is important to buy **<u>plastic folders</u>** to help keep your child organized as they travel to each teacher.



All students need the following:

- 5 plain **plastic** two-pocket folders (green, blue, purple, red, and yellow)
- 4 composition notebooks
- a soft-sided zipper pencil pouch
- 3 packs of #2 pencils
- Pencil top or big erasers
- 2 boxes of 24 count crayons
- 1 pack of colored pencils
- 5 glue sticks
- scissors

Six pencils, scissors, 1 box of crayons, glue, and colored pencils need to fit inside the pencil pouch. All other supplies will be collected for students to use later in the school year. These will be kept with your child's name.

- Earbuds or headphones (must be wired and placed into Ziploc bag with name labeled)
