The wisdom imparted by ancient Rishis has not only enriched the realm of inner science but has also played a pivotal role in shaping and advancing modern scientific understanding.

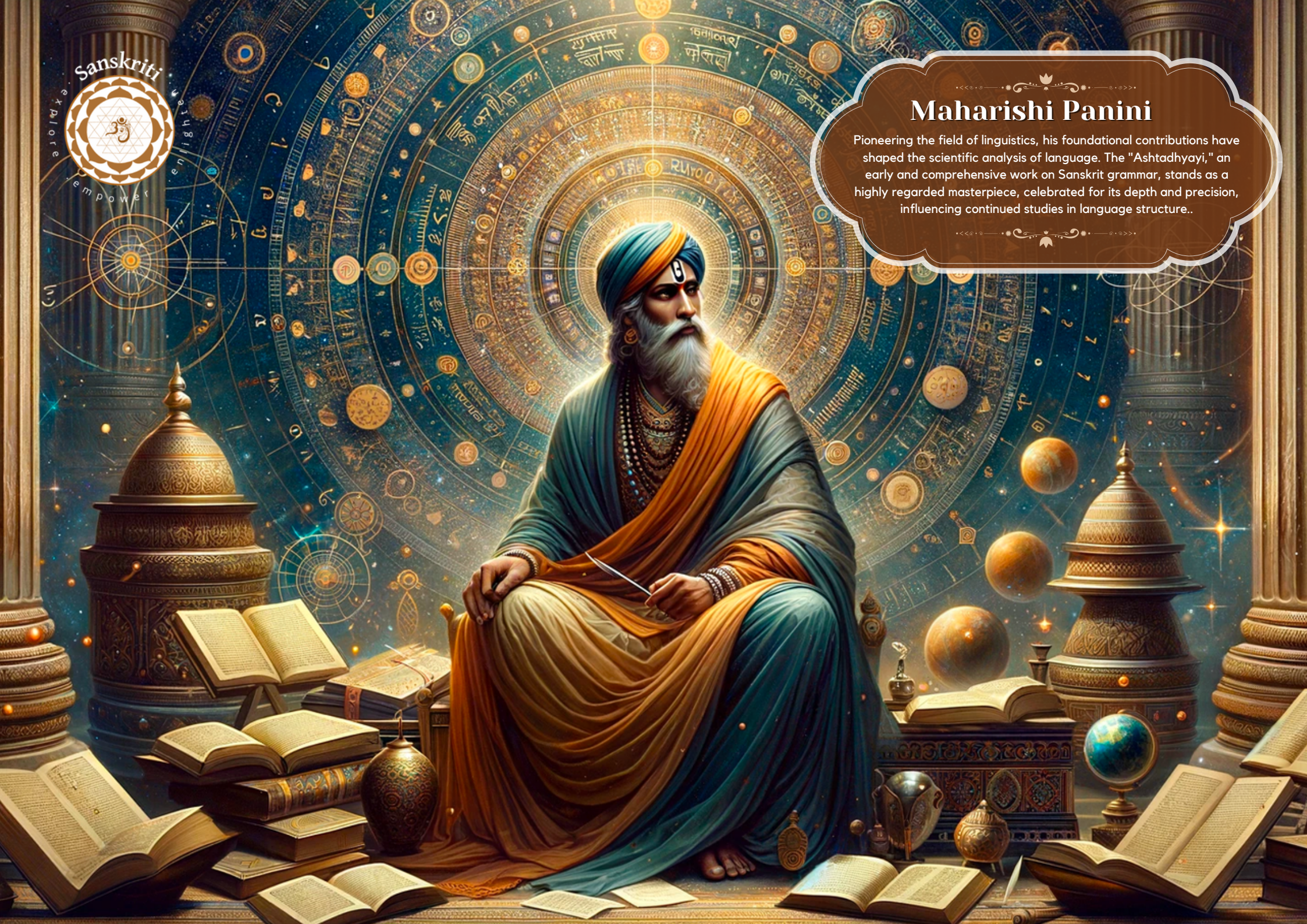

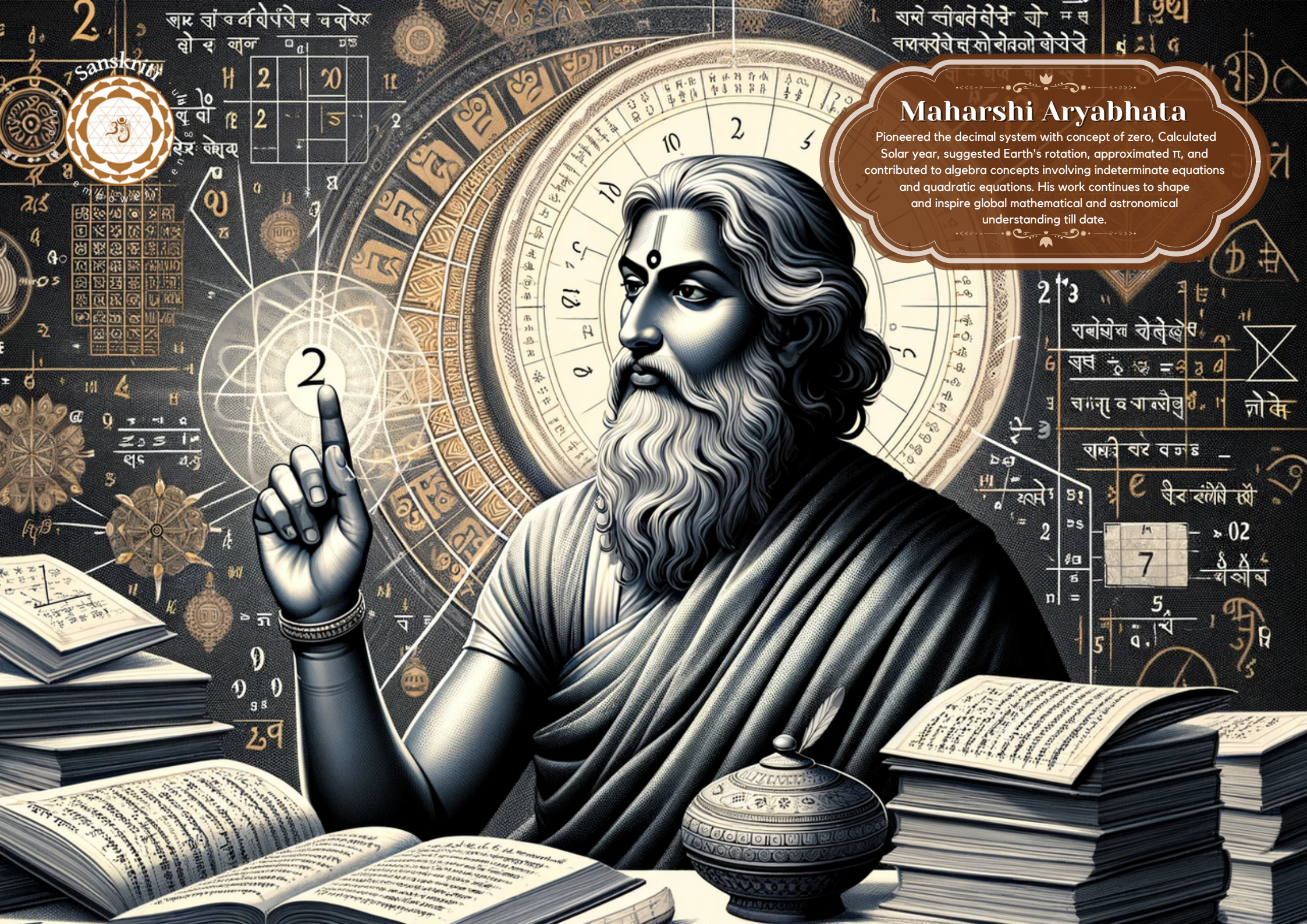

Pioneered the decimal system with concept of zero, Calculated Solar year, suggested Earth's rotation, approximated  $\pi$ , and contributed to algebra concepts involving indeterminate equations and quadratic equations. His work continues to shape and inspire global mathematical and astronomical understanding till date.

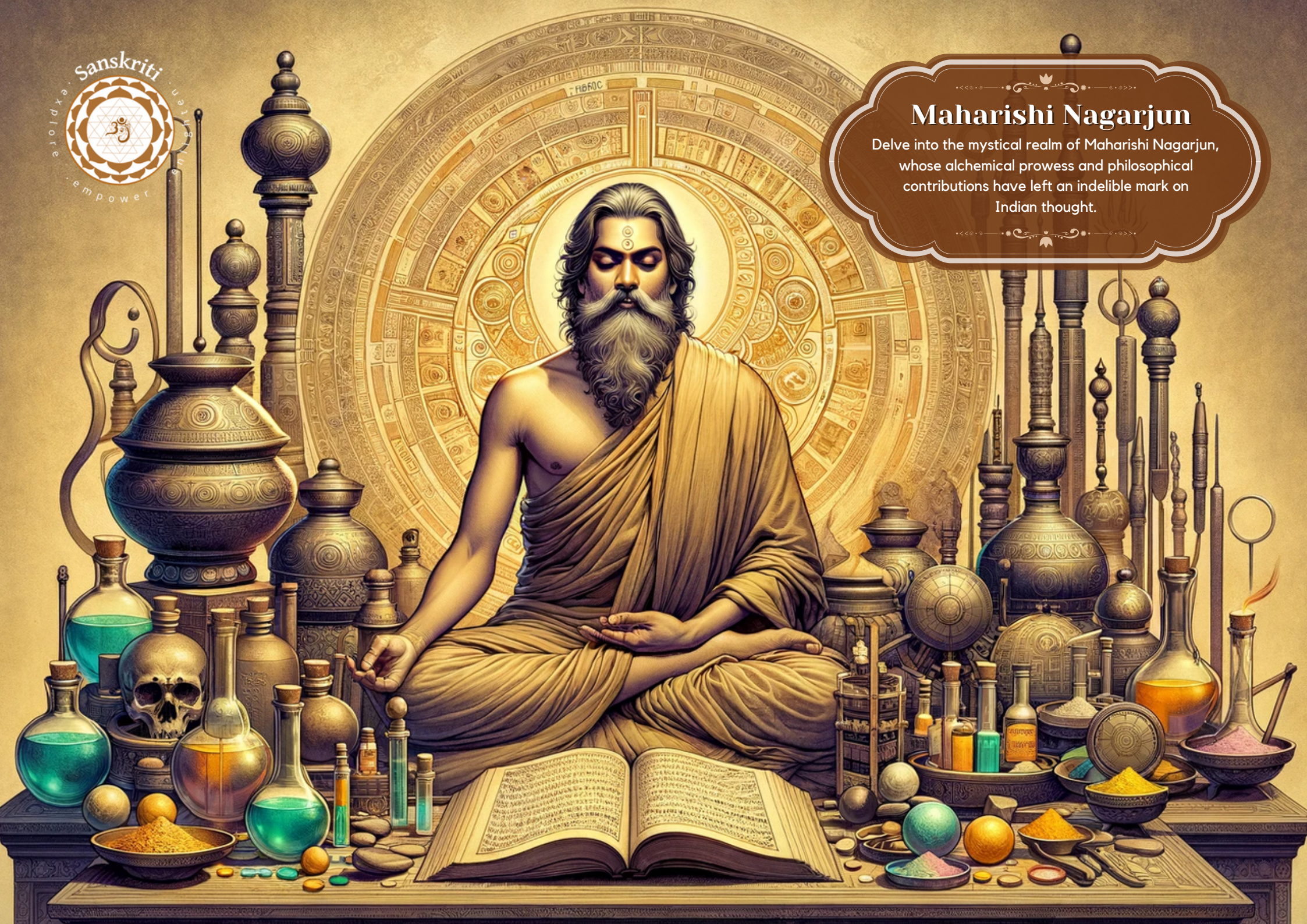

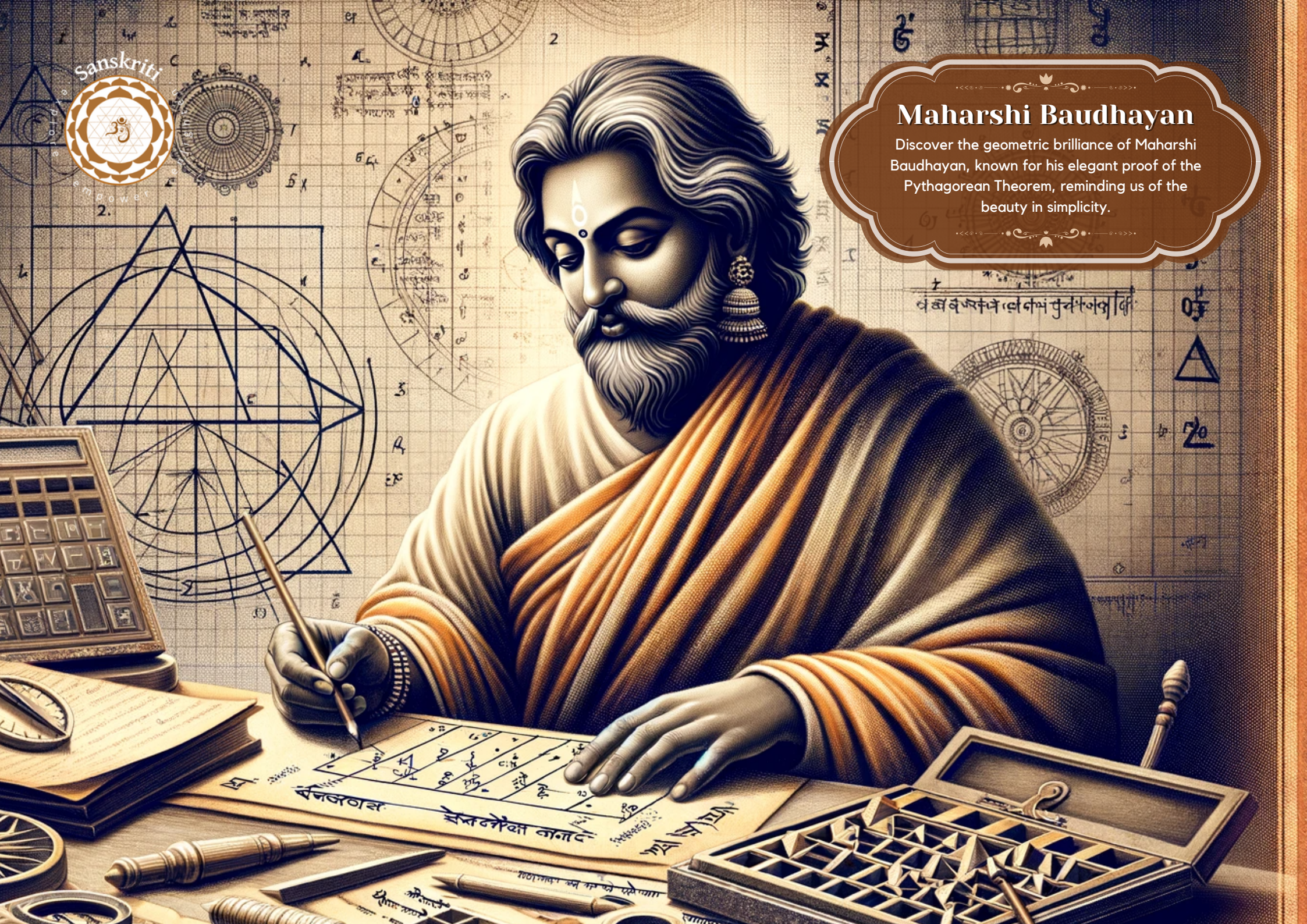

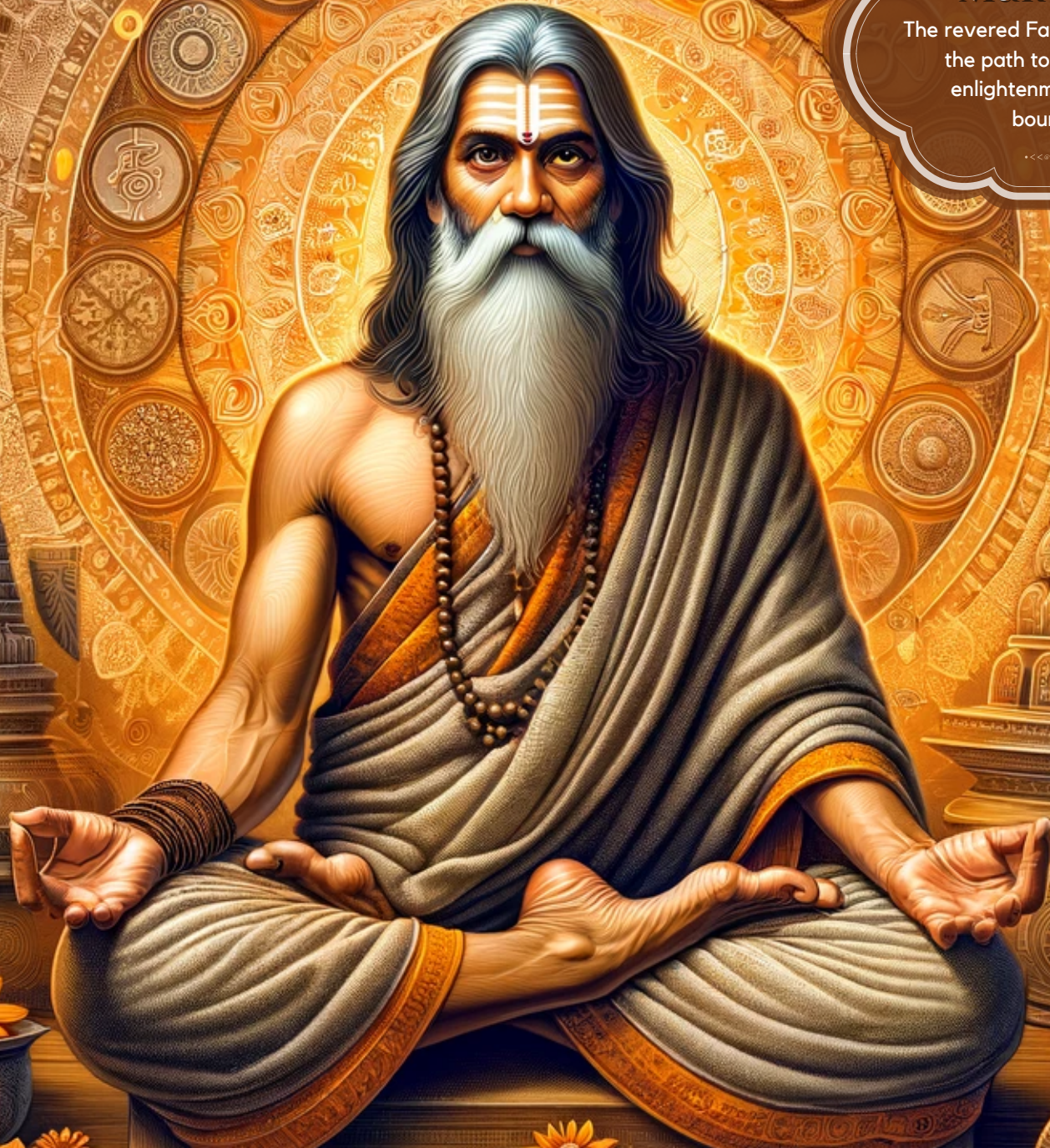
