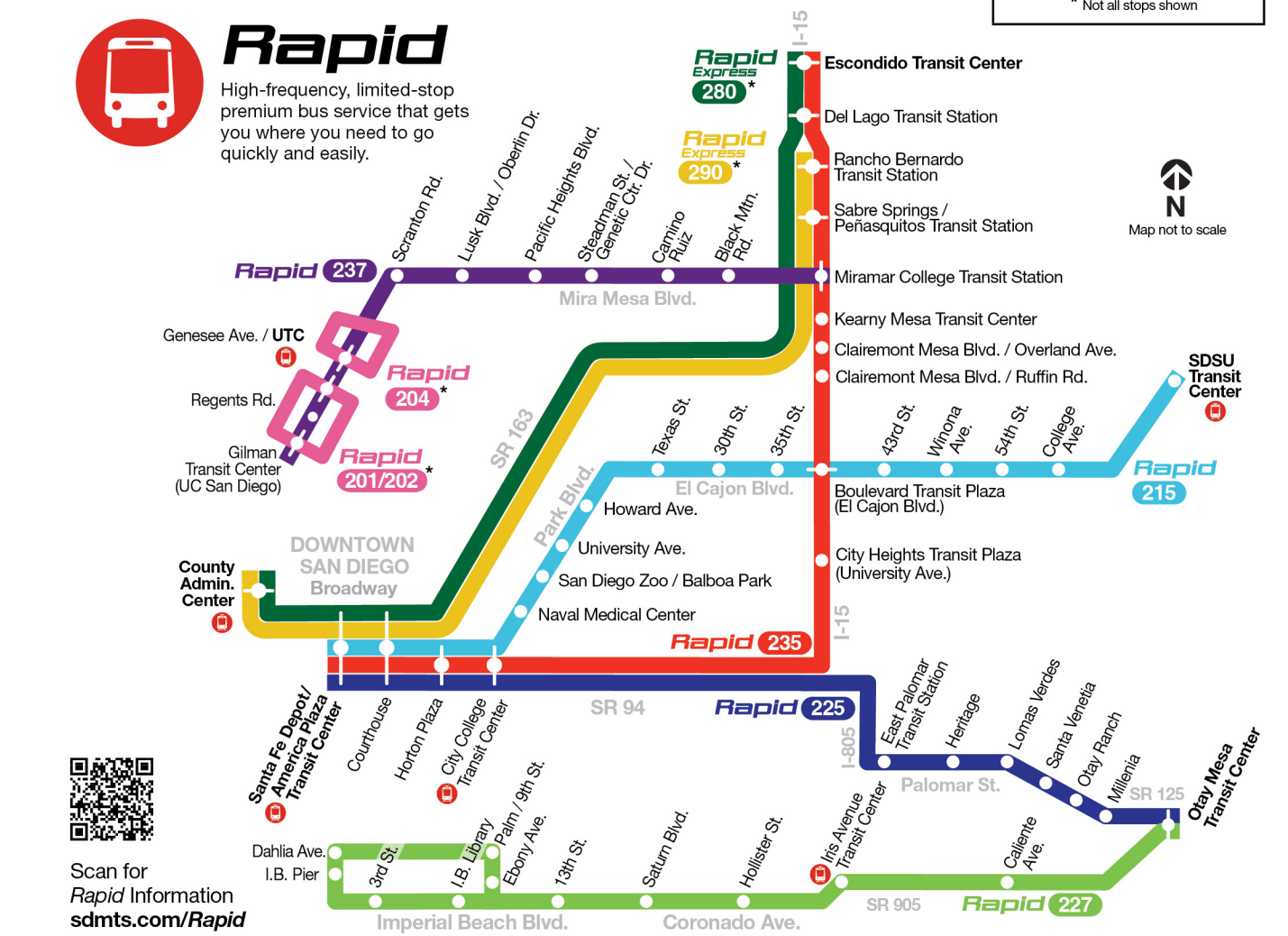

Fares and Passes

- One-Way-Fares**
- With a PRONTO card or mobile app, one-way fares are valid for unlimited transfers within two hours.
 - A one-way fare will be deducted each time a rider taps their PRONTO card or scans their PRONTO mobile app (unless within the free two-hour transfer window), up to the value of a Day Pass.
 - Trolley fares can be purchased at any Trolley station.
- Senior, Disabled, Medicare (SDM) and Youth fares** require valid identification when riding.
- Cash or Debit/Credit card tap one-way fares do not include transfers to any other bus or trolley line, and do not contribute towards earning a Day Pass.
 - Exact fare is required on buses (no change given).

Family Weekends: On Saturdays and Sundays, up to two children (age 12 and under) may ride free with a fare-paying adult (age 18 or older) on all MTS routes.		
Holiday Friends Ride Free: On New Year's Day, Memorial Day, Independence Day, Labor Day, Thanksgiving Day and Christmas Day, a friend may ride free with a fare-paying customer on all MTS routes.		

- Day and Month Passes**
- With PRONTO, riders can pay-as-they-go to earn the best fare, every time! Riders will be charged the appropriate one-way fare as they travel, up to the value of a Day Pass in a calendar day, and the value of the Month Pass in a calendar month.
 - Day and Month Passes allow for unlimited transfers during that day/month. Month Passes are valid from the first day of the month through the last, and can be purchased in advance, or using pay-as-you-go capabilities. Day Passes are not available for pre-purchase. (The COASTER requires up front payments for Day and Month Passes.)
 - PRONTO cards cannot be purchased or reloaded on buses. Only one-way fares can be purchased onboard buses. Tap debit/credit card or provide exact change. No transfers, does not contribute towards earning a Day Pass.

- Paying on Bus fareboxes and PRONTO ticket machines:**
- Tap your contactless credit/debit card or mobile wallet to purchase a one-way Adult fare.
 - When paying with cash, select either Adult or Reduced Fare.
 - No change is available on buses (one-way fares only).
 - Accepted Bills - \$1, \$5, \$10, \$20
 - Accepted Coins - pennies (bus only), nickels, dimes, quarters, dollar coins (all except Eisenhower Dollars).
 - PRONTO ticket machines can distribute a maximum of \$5 in change.

PRONTO Transit Fare

Always Get the Best Fare
Riders can load money to their PRONTO account and pay-as-they-go to always get the best fare! Load money onto a PRONTO card or mobile app, then riders must tap or scan on a validator every time before boarding.
A one-way fare will be deducted with each tap or scan, up to the value of a Day or Month Pass. Riders never pay more than the value of a Day Pass (\$6 Adult, \$3 Senior/Disabled/Medicare and Youth), in a day, or the value of a Month Pass (\$72 Adult, \$23 SDM/Youth) in a calendar month!

PRONTO Card
PRONTO cards cost \$2 at ticket machines, retail outlets or the MTS Transit Store. At the time of purchase, riders will need to load a minimum value onto their PRONTO card (\$3 at the Transit Store or ticket vending machine, \$5 at retail outlets). Riders can reload money (or pre-pay for a Month Pass) instantly online at RidePRONTO.com, at ticket machines, retail outlets or the MTS Transit Store.

Reduced Fares
All PRONTO cards will look the same. Reduced fare designations (Senior, Disabled, Medicare, and Youth) are identified at the account level. Riders can have their PRONTO card or mobile app account switched to a reduced fare category online at RidePRONTO.com, by visiting the MTS Transit Store. Riders with a reduced fare must travel with proof of eligibility at all times. A PRONTO Photo ID card is encouraged, but not required (available at the MTS Transit Store). Approved IDs include: Government-issue Photo ID with birth date (seniors), student school photo ID, Medicare card & Government Photo ID, California DMV Placard ID & Government Photo ID, California Senior ID card, MTS Senior/Disabled Photo ID, NCTD Senior/Disabled Photo ID, Veterans Administration Award Letter confirming a minimum 50% service connected disability.
Senior Eligibility: Age 65+, Youth Eligibility: Age 18 & Under (kids five and under ride free).

PRONTO Mobile App
The PRONTO mobile app is available for download on Apple and Android phones. Riders will need to add a payment method (credit or debit card) at the time of registration. Riders will have a virtual PRONTO card in their mobile app that can be reloaded with money or a Month Pass instantly.

PRONTO Ticket Machines
Select product on screen and follow prompts to purchase a fare. Retain a one-way paper ticket, load money or a Month Pass to PRONTO.

- Loading Money to PRONTO:** Riders will need to load a minimum of \$3 to their PRONTO card at ticket machines.
- Month Pass:** Valid from the first to last day of month.
- One-Way:** One-way cash fares can be purchased at ticket machines, but do not allow for transfers or contribute towards earning a Day or Month Pass.
- Cash:** Up to \$5 in change given.

TAP or SCAN - REQUIRED BEFORE BOARDING.
Failure to tap or scan may result in a citation.

Reduced Fares

All PRONTO cards will look the same. Reduced fare designations (Senior, Disabled, Medicare, and Youth) are identified at the account level. Riders can have their PRONTO card or mobile app account switched to a reduced fare category online at RidePRONTO.com, by visiting the MTS Transit Store. Riders with a reduced fare must travel with proof of eligibility at all times. A PRONTO Photo ID card is encouraged, but not required (available at the MTS Transit Store). Approved IDs include: Government-issue Photo ID with birth date (seniors), student school photo ID, Medicare card & Government Photo ID, California DMV Placard ID & Government Photo ID, California Senior ID card, MTS Senior/Disabled Photo ID, NCTD Senior/Disabled Photo ID, Veterans Administration Award Letter confirming a minimum 50% service connected disability.
Senior Eligibility: Age 65+, Youth Eligibility: Age 18 & Under (kids five and under ride free).

Ticket Machine

PRONTO Ticket Machines
Select product on screen and follow prompts to purchase a fare. Retain a one-way paper ticket, load money or a Month Pass to PRONTO.

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- Month Pass:** Valid from the first to last day of month.
- One-Way:** One-way cash fares can be purchased at ticket machines, but do not allow for transfers or contribute towards earning a Day or Month Pass.
- Cash:** Up to \$5 in change given.

Trolley Station Validator
Free-standing Station Validators are located on both sides of all Trolley platforms. Before a Trolley arrives, "tap" the PRONTO card or scan the mobile app to deduct a fare. Trolley Security may ask for a valid fare or to show additional proof of eligibility if using a reduced fare.

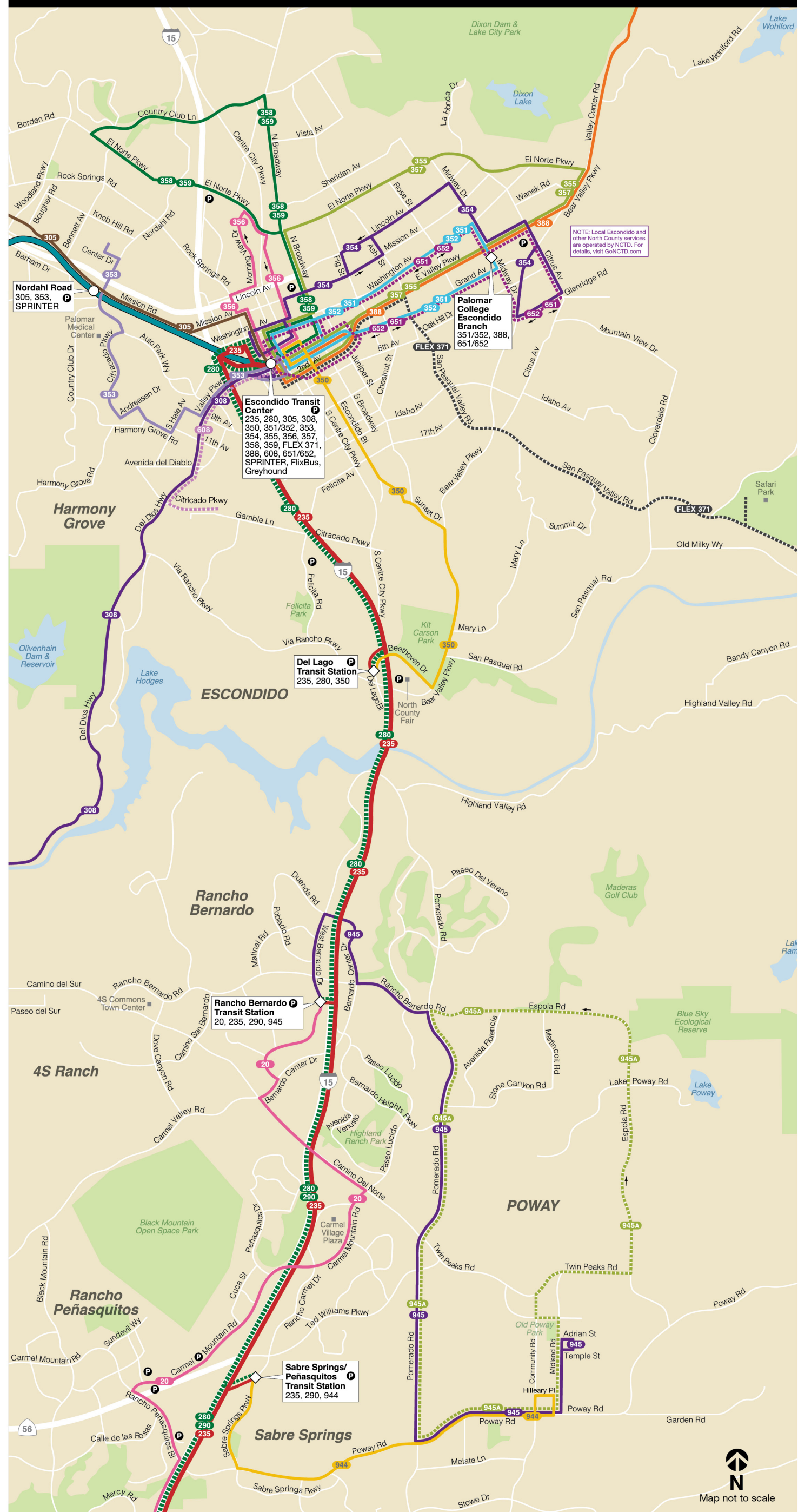
Bus Validator
Bus Validators are located in the front of all MTS buses. Fareboxes accept one-way cash fares, and PRONTO cards and mobile app. Tap a PRONTO card or scan the barcode on the mobile app when boarding. If using cash, use exact change (not valid for transfers or best fare capabilities). No money can be added to PRONTO onboard buses.

Contactless Payment

Tap a credit/debit card or contactless mobile wallet or wearable device at any PRONTO validator. A one-way fare (\$2.50) will be deducted, and is valid for two hours. Riders will be charged a one-way fare each time they tap outside a two-hour window (not valid for best fare capabilities).
