ART DESCRIPTIONS

It is not always easy to know what you are buying, there are so many words out there, and they change often, but here is a list of terms used to describe artwork, always make sure you know, what it is you are purchasing.

<u>Original</u>

Term meaning an original painting, by the artist, this can be in any medium, including Oil, Watercolour, Acrylic. Mixed media.

<u>Print</u>

Meaning a print/a copy taken from an original painting, printed onto paper or canvas

Limited edition print

A print/a copy taken from the original painting and printed onto paper or canvas, but only a limited amount produced.

Giclee Print

A fine art paper print, produced on very good quality paper using the best digital printing quality.

Hand Embellished

A copy/a print on canvas or paper, with added paint or embellishments, sometime by the artists, sometime by the print producer.

Studio edition

A copy/a print on canvas or paper, with added paint or details usually added by the artist.

Lino print/woodblock print

A handmade print, using ink or watercolour, that has been applied to a carved lino or woodblock, usually produced on paper in limited numbers.
