This Transfer Pathway represents one example of how to complete an associate and bachelor degree. Students should work closely with advisors at both institutions to discuss options.

This pathway awards maximum credit for an associate degree from Stark State College (SSC), streamlining completion of a bachelor's degree from The University of Akron (UA). The pathway identifies 65 transfer credits to UA from SSC that would complete the AA degree—and also fulfilling most of UA's core requirements and guaranteeing junior status

Pathway students should consult with their academic advisor to develop a plan to address math pre-requisites so that MATH 223 is completed prior to transfer.

A Stark State advisor can also assist students with developing a graduation plan for full- or part-time study.

Pathway students must complete UA's Spreadsheet Modeling course (6200:250) prior to transfer to have the opportunity to complete the BBA degree in four full time semesters at UA.

UA's Domestic Diversity requirement is addressed by SSC's SOC 225 Cultural Diversity course.

Students may complete UA's Critical Thinking requirement with one of the following SSC courses:

PHIL 122 or HIS 221 or HIS 222

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
