

Terms of Agreement

- A. The Chief Academic Officers or designees of the parties to this agreement will implement the terms of this agreement, including identifying and incorporating any changes into subsequent agreements, assuring compliance with system policy, procedure and guidelines, and conducting a periodic review of this agreement.
- B. Program curriculum and requirements listed in the Program Articulation Table may change.
- C. This Articulation Agreement is effective on 11/4/11 and shall remain in effect until 11/4/16 unless terminated or amended by either party with 90 days prior written notice.
- D. This Articulation Agreement will be reviewed by both parties beginning on or after 11/4/12.
- E. The College agrees to facilitate communication between its graduates and upcoming graduates with representatives of the University through access to students on campus, posting and distribution of the University's promotional literature, and access to student and graduate listings as mutual agreed between the institutions.
