**Transfer Guide for Stark State College Health and Public Sciences Division,
 Associate Degree Program in Nursing (ADN)**

This Transfer Guide provides information to assist Stark State nursing students in selecting courses appropriate for meeting the requirements of Malone University and the RN/BSN Program for RNs in the School of Nursing and Health Sciences.

Listed are the 17 courses nursing students complete for the Associate Degree in Nursing (ADN) program at Stark State College. These courses total 64 semester credit hours, all of which are transferable to Malone University. A grade of 'C' or higher is required for each support course and each nursing course. All other courses are transferable according to the Malone University policy. Transcripts are required from each institution providing the courses and maintaining files on the courses completed.

In addition to the 64 semester credit hours, students need to complete 24 semester credit hours. The 24 semester credit hours should include Liberal Arts courses which may include English Literature, Fine Arts (Art/Music/Theater History or Appreciation), Foreign Language, History, Philosophy, Psychology, or Social Sciences (Economics, Political Science) and cannot be any course included in the 17 courses of the Associate Degree in Nursing program at Stark State. The remaining credit hours are taken as electives, all of which must be completed prior to graduation from Malone University.
