** Transfer students must complete the required bridge coursework, establish a GPA of 2.75 or higher, and meet other requirements in order to be accepted into advanced studies. In order to apply for advanced studies students must also submit Praxis core test scores and complete an interview/essay. Requirements to graduate with the BSE degree program: To graduate, students must have minimum 122 credits hours, 39 upper-division credits hours of coursework, a minimum 2.000 major GPA and minimum 2.750 cumulative GPA. They must also fulfill an approved experiential learning experience, a two-course diversity requirement (domestic and global), complete a writing intensive course with a minimum C (2.000) grade. More specific graduation requirement information can be found in the Academic Policies section of the Kent State University Catalog (www.kent.edu/catalog).

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It is recommended that students intending to pursue the Bachelor of Science in Education degree in Early Childhood Education through Kent State University Tuscarawas Campus consult with academic advisors at both Stark State College and Kent State University Tuscarawas Campus.
