

Community Infrastructure Levy (CIL) – Annual Report of: Thame Town Council

CIL Regulation 62A (121B)

A parish council must prepare a report for any financial year ("the reported year") in which it received CIL receipts.

CIL receipts received in April 2019 and/or October 2019 must be reported at the end of the financial year, i.e. March 2020

Report must be produced by December 2020 latest.

*** Regulation 59E**

This regulation applies to CIL receipts received by a local town or parish council that the local council:-

- (a) has not applied to support the development of its area within 5 years of receipt; or
- (b) has applied otherwise than in accordance with regulation 59C.

Regulation 59C: the local council must use CIL receipts to support the development of the local council's area, or any part of it, by funding:

- (a) the provision, improvement, replacement, operation or maintenance of infrastructure, or
- (b) anything else that is concerned with addressing the demands that development places on an area.
