The OA is charged with recognizing occupations on a national level and follows the guidelines in accordance with Title 29 of the Code of Federal Regulations (CFR) (Title 29 CFR, part 29.4 Criteria for Apprenticeable Occupations) to assist us in determining if an occupation should be recognized as apprenticeable.
