



BIOSECURITY

3 key principles to protect from Foot and Mouth Disease (FMD)



- Cleaning
- Disinfection









ACCESS:

Control and monitor visitor/personnel access to animal sheds.







VACCINATION:

Administer primary vaccination of 2 doses: first dose at 3-4 months age, and second dose 3-4 weeks later. Followed by regular vaccination every 6 months.





TRADE:

Always buy animals from reliable sources.










QUARANTINE:

Isolate newly bought animals for at least 2 weeks and observe their clinical behaviour.









ANIMAL HOUSING:

Clean animal shed frequently and maintain good hygiene.







TOOLS AND TROUGHS:

Regularly clean feeding, watering troughs and other equipment.





PERSONAL HYGIENE:

Always wash your hands, shoes, clothing and tools after handling the animals.







SEPARATE:

Keep clean clothes, shoes and equipment separate from contaminated area and items.









DISINFECTION:

Always clean first, disinfect later. Use appropriate disinfectant as recommended by a veterinarian.
