The most often mentioned quote from William Temple is his statement that, 'the Church is the only society on earth that exists for the benefit of non-members'. A number of years ago the then Director of the William Temple Foundation told me that nowhere could those words be found within Temple's writings and no attribution of them to be found anywhere other than in common usage. As misquotes go it is a good one. It makes us think about what we are doing 'in church', why and for whom. It is easy to see our worship in terms of drama, concert, and performance - good liturgy contains all three; but the chief difference when comparing Divine Service with cultural performance is that the audience is not the congregation but God, and the performer is not the minister, nor the choir alone, but the whole gathered assembly offering worship and praise, glory and honour to God. Our worship is our offering and, bringing us back to words attributed to Temple, we offer our worship for everyone not just for ourselves. And in doing so we exist as an invitation for all to come to Christ, the head of the Church, who sees neither member nor nonmember, but friends.
