

## Services and Music October 2024

Congratulations to Worcester Cathedral Voluntary Choir, celebrating its 150th anniversary this month!

We are looking forward to welcoming former members of the choir back to Worcester on Sunday 13 October to take part in a special Sung Eucharist followed by a Gala Lunch. The service will include an anthem commissioned especially for the occasion by Paul Trepte, Organist Emeritus of Ely Cathedral and a former director of the Voluntary Choir.

The Vollers were founded in October 1874 as a choir of men and boys. Their main duties were to sing evensong every Sunday and to fill in when the Cathedral Choir was unavailable. In recent years, they sang on a live BBC TV Christmas broadcast, took part in tours to Paris and Brussels and recorded two CDs.

In 2021, the Vollers were re-formed as a choir of boys and girls aged about 8 and upwards, enabling children from across Worcestershire to take part in regular music-making at the cathedral. As well as their usual Sunday duties, they also take part in other services: most recently they sang at the installation of the Dean; and in the next few weeks and months they will be singing at the Farmers' Harvest Service, the Remembrance Service, and the opening of the Victorian Christmas Fayre.
